15-Cent Commemorative Stamp—International Year of the Child

Description. The 15-cent International Year of the Child commemorative stamp will be first placed on sale at Philadelphia, PA 19104 on February 15, 1979. The General Assembly of the United Nations passed a Resolution declaring 1979 as the International Year of the Child. 1979 also marks the 20th anniversary of the United Nations Declaration of the Rights of the Child. The Secretary General of the United Nations requested each member country to observe the anniversary.

Collectors. First day cover cancellations may be obtained by one of the following methods:

a. Customers Affixing Stamps. Customers are encouraged to purchase their own stamps at their local post offices and affix them to their own envelopes. All envelopes must be addressed. Peelable address labels are recommended and a filler card of postal card thickness should be inserted in each cover. Orders must be postmarked by March 31, 1979, and should be addressed to: First Day Cancellation, Postmaster, Philadelphia, PA 19104. No remittance is required.

b. Postal Service Affixing Stamps. Request first day cancellations from: International Year of the Child

Stamp, Postmaster, Philadelphia, PA 19104 (see PSM, section 257.2). Request must be postmarked not later than March 31, 1979. Remittance is required for the face value of each stamp.

Selected United States mint stamps will be available at the Philatelic Sales Branch, Washington, DC 20265 beginning February 16, 1979.

Supply. Production difficulties have developed at the Bureau of Engraving and Printing which will result in a delay in the delivery to some post offices.

In order to have a supply of stamps at nearly all post offices by February 15, 1979, two automatic distributions will be made by the Bureau of Engraving and Printing. The first shipment will be approximately one half the quantity normally furnished. The second shipment will follow immediately and should be completed by March 1, 1979.

Postal data centers have been requested to prepare two automatic distribution printouts with related invoices and labels for use by sectional centers in making the initial and subsequent distribution to associate post offices.

Sectional centers and post offices with more than 949 revenue units which maintain an automatic distribution for new concept offices (NCO's) and local stations and branches should reduce the quantity of stamps furnished initially to insure that all postal outlets have a supply by first day sale.

Before requisitioning additional stamps (**Item 464**), consider that the stock should be depleted before April 16, 1979, at all post office outlets, except designated philatelic windows and postal stores.

Post offices with 950 or more revenue units requiring additional bulk quantities: immediately requisition on Form 3356, *Stamp Requisition—Bulk Quantities*, from the Bureau of Engraving and Printing.

All post offices requiring additional stamps in less than bulk quantities:

FLSA Poster

Postal facilities have received one or more copies of Poster 42, *To Employees of the U.S. Postal Service*. This poster updates the minimum wage requirements of the Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) and replaces the previous poster, WH Publication 1414, issued in October 1975.

The Department of Labor requires that this poster be conspicuously displayed in all facilities where employees work who are covered by the FLSA. It is suggested that bulletin boards near time clock areas be used for this purpose.

Newly established facilities, and installations needing additional copies of this poster, should submit *Form 7380, Requisition for Supplies*, to the appropriate area supply center.—*Office of Compensation, 1-18-79.*

Panels. A limited number of 8½ by 11¼ inch commemorative series stamp panels will be available only through mail order from the Philatelic Sales Branch, Washington, DC 20265. The panels are printed on heavy art paper suitable for mounting.—*Customer Services Dept.—1-18-79.*

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10-Cent George Rogers Clark Commemorative Postal Card

Description. The 10-cent George Rogers Clark commemorative postal card will be first placed on sale at Vincennes, IN 47591 on February 23, 1979. General Henry Hamilton, the British commander at Detroit, captured Vincennes in December 1778. Clark responded in 1779 by leading his frontiersmen through flooded bottomlands and freezing weather without adequate supplies to retake Vincennes on February 24. His expedition did much to free the western frontier from Indian raids and to give American forces a strategic hold upon the Northwest.

Collectors. Request first day cancellations from: George Rogers Clark Postal Card, Postmaster, Vincennes, IN 47591. To eliminate the requirement for Postal Service personnel to apply return addresses, customers are requested to send self-addressed envelopes of an appropriate size or return address labels with their orders. Requests must be postmarked no later than March 10, 1979. Remittance is required for the face value of each card.

The George Rogers Clark postal card will be available at the Philatelic Sales Branch, Washington, DC 20265, beginning February 24, 1979.

Supply. There will not be an automatic distribution of the 10-cent George Rogers Clark postal card. All post offices may requisition the George Rogers Clark postal card in quantities of 500, 1,000, 2,000, and 5,000, and multiples of 5,000 by immediately submitting **Form 3216, Requisition for Postal Cards—Bulk**

City Taxes Based on Residence

Note: Postmasters or officials in charge of postal installations in the states listed are requested to post a copy of this article.

Public Law 95-365 requires the withholding of city taxes (or county taxes) from the wages of employees whose place of residence is within the taxing jurisdiction of any city (or county) which has entered into a withholding agreement with the Secretary of the Treasury.

A list of the cities and the type of taxes involved are shown below. Note: No counties are included at present because their existing agreements with the Treasury cover occupation taxes rather than taxes based on residence.

Any employee living within the taxing jurisdiction of a city listed who is not now having that city's tax deducted from wages **must** complete a **Form 4 Employees City or County Withholding Certificate**. The completed form must be forwarded to the servicing Postal Data Center through regular payroll document channels (see exhibit below for sample).

Questions regarding liability for such taxes should be directed by individual employees to the taxing authority in the city imposing the tax.

In the exhibit the employee is shown as living in Philadelphia but working in Drexel Hill (Finance No. 41-2116). He enters the number of withholding exemptions he claims on his Federal/State Tax. The only additional items required are the **name of the city and PDC tax code** as shown in the exhibit. In the exhibit the employee has indicated a request to withhold Philadelphia (Tax Code 651) from his salary even though he is employed at Drexel Hill. The use of this additional information will insure correct deduction.

Forms 4 are available at supply centers. Emergency requests to comply with this notice may be made to the Payroll Requirements Division, Room 5340,

Personnel officers in the states shown should retain a copy of this article. International Mail—Iran

Effective immediately, civilian international airmail service to Iran is suspended. Only surface services are currently available to Iran.

Airmail items addressed to Iran which have already been deposited should be endorsed, *Airmail Service Temporarily Suspended*, and returned to the sender. Send airmail addressed to Iran which does not indicate a return address to the dead letter or dead parcel post office as appropriate.

In accordance with POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL 147.221c, postage refunds are authorized on mail which has been returned to the sender due to this suspension of air service. Customers must file an application for a postage refund in accordance with PSM 147.24.

Military mail destined for Iran is not affected by this notice.—Rates & Classification Dept., 1-18-79.

California State Tax Withholding Change

The State of California has changed its tax withholding rates. The changes in the state withholding tax will first be reflected in the pay checks for California employees with checks dated February 16, 1979, for pay period 4.

Quantities, (using item no. 270) to Postal Card Unit, Room 332A, Government Printing Office, Washington, DC 20401. Requisitions for quantities of less than 500 may only be submitted to your stamp distribution office.—Customer Services Dept., 1-18-79.

International Express Mail

Effective immediately, the United States Postal Service will exchange International Express Mail shipments with Taiwan. These Express Mail shipments may weigh up to 33 pounds and may contain letters, business documents, commercial papers, and merchandise.

Two basic service offerings are available for International Express Mail to Taiwan: *Custom Designed Service* and *On Demand Service*. See Exhibits A and B for rates to Taiwan.

The following procedures and regulations apply to International Express Mail shipments received from and sent to Taiwan.

Inbound

All International Express Mail shipments from Taiwan are subject to prompt customs examination. After such customs examination, Express Mail merchandise will bear either (1) an endorsement such as *Passed Free U.S. Customs*, indicating that the mail does not contain dutiable items or (2) the red adhesive Treasury Department envelope containing Customs Form 3419, *Customs Mail Entry*, indicating that the mail contains dutiable items.

Postal employees at delivering post offices shall promptly examine all incoming International Express Mail shipments to detect items bearing Customs Form 3419 and shall deliver such items pursuant to the delivery procedures for dutiable mail.

Postage due stamps in the amount of \$1.00 must be applied to insure collection of the required customs clearance and delivery fee for articles on which customs duty is collected.

Outbound

Customers must complete the customs declarations specified in section 221.4 and 327.2 of Publication 42, *International Mail*, for merchandise shipments in either *Custom Designed* or *On-Demand Express Mail Service* to Taiwan. International Express Mail items containing merchandise are insured against loss or damage at no additional charge, in accordance with the merchandise insurance provisions for domestic Express Mail set forth in *POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL*, 189.43. Prominent American Mint Set

The *Prominent American Mint Set*, a hard cover book featuring profiles of the 26 individuals of the Prominent American stamp issues, will go on sale February 1 in all philatelic centers and will be available by mail from the Philatelic Sales Branch.

The new philatelic product, Item 938, contains 24 regular stamps issued between 1965 and 1975 and will sell for \$12. The stamp packets and the books are being shipped by two different contractors and although the shipping schedules are identical, the cartons may not arrive simultaneously. The cartons of stamp packets contain four packages of 25 shrink-wrapped packets each and will be shipped by registered mail. The books are packaged 30 to a carton and will arrive through regular mail channels.

Each post office must verify receipt of equal quantities of both stamp packets and books. Notify the regional Retail Branch of any discrepancies. Shipment is scheduled for January 15, 1979.—*Customer Services Dept., 1-18-79.*

Address Correction Requested

When a piece of First-Class mail bearing the endorsement *Address Correction Requested* is addressed to a customer who has *moved and left no address*, the mail piece is to be returned to the sender from the office of last address endorsed with the reason for non-delivery, as prescribed in Section 158.7, *POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL*. No charge is to be made for this service.—*Rates & Classification and Delivery Services Depts., 1-18-79.*

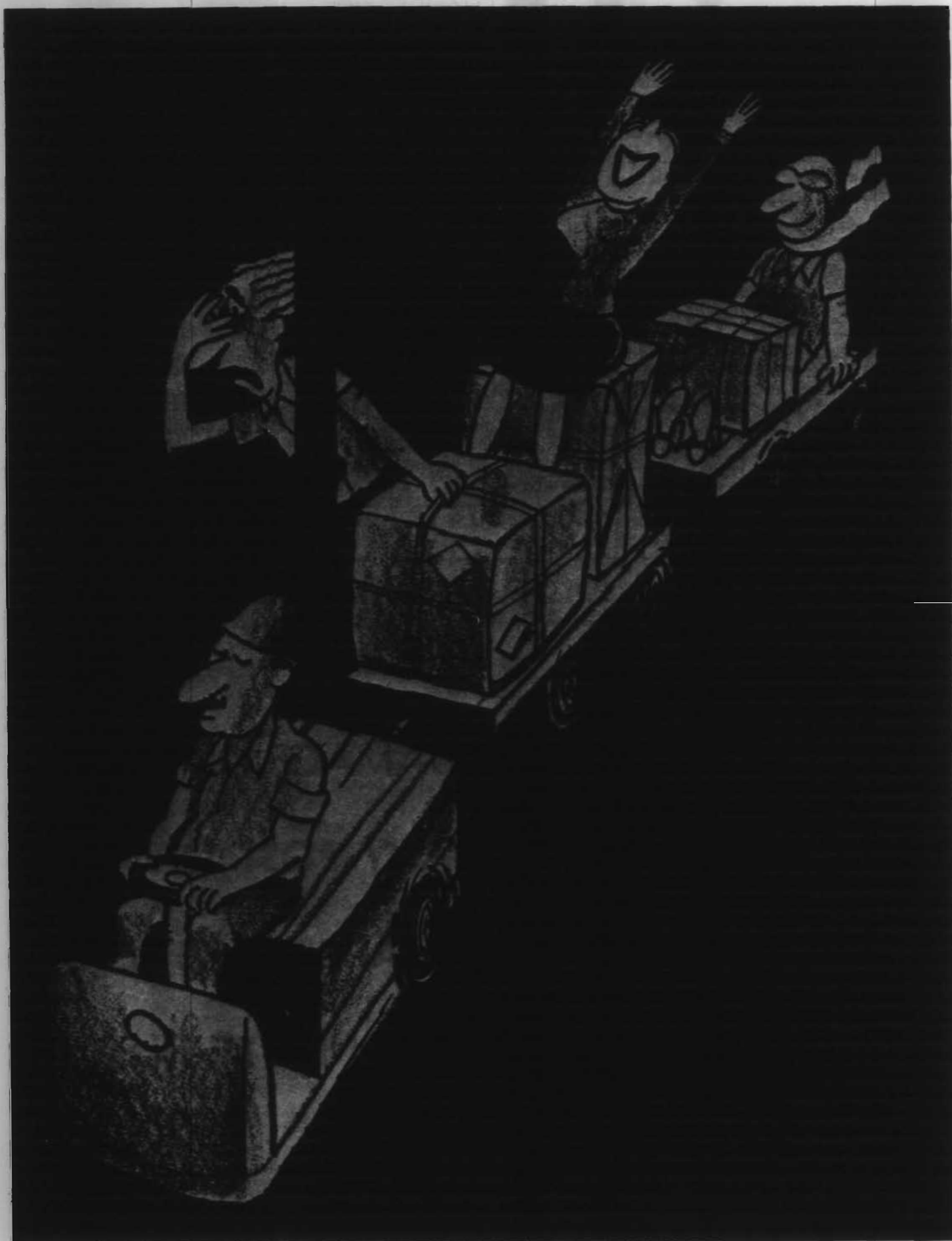
