#### SPECIAL BULLETIN

#### NEW RATES

The Governors of the Postal Service have acted to modify the Postal Rate Commission's recommended decision and have directed the Postal Service to implement changes to postal rates. The Board of Governors has directed that the changes are to be implemented at 12:01 a.m. November 1, 1981.

This Special Bulletin contains domestic postal rates which will be in effect on November 1. Certain international postal rates also will change on November 1. These international rate changes are a consequence of the domestic rate changes. They are included in this Special Bulletin.

The classification structure is not changed. Initial distribution of Poster 103 and Notice 59, Domestic Postage Rates, Fees, and Information, reflecting the rates adopted by the Governors will be made directly to post offices.

#### I. DOMESTIC RATES

#### A. General

There will be changes to the following rates and fees:

- 1. First-Class Mail (includes priority mail).
- 2. Express Mail.
- 3. Second-Class.
- 4. Third-Class.
- 5. Fourth-Class bound printed matter and library rates.

#### B. First-Class Mail

- 1. Full Letter Rate First-Class Mail. The rate for First-Class letters will be 20 cents for first ounce or fraction of an ounce and 17 cents for each additional ounce or fraction of an ounce, not to exceed 12 ounces.
  - 2. Cards. The card rate will be 13 cents per piece.
- 3. Presort First-Class Rate. The presort rate for regular First-Class letter mail will be 3 cents less than the regular First-Class letter rates. The presort rate for cards will be 1 cent less than the card rate.

- 4. Carrier Route First-Class. For First-Class letters the rate will be the full First-Class rate less 4 cents per piece for the first ounce or fraction of an ounce and 16 cents for each additional ounce or fraction of an ounce. For First-Class cards, the rate will be the full First-Class card rate less 2 cents per piece.
  - 5. Zone Rated (Priority) Mail. The rates will change.

#### C. Express Mail

The postage rates for Express Mail will change.

#### D. Second-Class Mail

Second-class rates will change.

Revised editions of Form 3541, Statement of Mailing—2nd-Class Pubs Except Controlled Circulation Publications and Form 3541-A, Statement of Mailing—Second-Class/Controlled Circulation Publications will be mailed

as soon as possible to all post offices which are authorized to accept mailings of copies of second-class publications. The correct applicable postal rates must be written on the mailing statements until the revised statements are distributed.

#### E. Third-Class Mail

Some rates will change (see page 13).

#### F. Fourth-Class Mail

The postal rates for bound printed matter and library rate mail will change.

Form 3605. Until the form is revised and distributed the applicable rates in Exhibit 711.2 for bound printed matter must be written on the 3605.

#### G. Special Services

There are no changes.

#### II. INTERNATIONAL POSTAL RATES

#### A. General

Concurrent with domestic mail postal rate modifications, new postal rates for certain categories of international mail that are related to the domestic schedules are also being modified. The rate changes include:

(1) Letters and Letter Package rates for Canada and Mexico are increased from 18 cents to 20 cents for the first ounce;

(2) Post Card rate for Canada and Mexico is increased from 12 cents to 13 cents each; and

(3) Regular Printed Matter and Small Packets (surface) rates. The weight steps zero through eight are adjusted to the levels indicated below due to changes in the domestic third-class single piece rate.

These rates are effective at 12:01 a.m., November 1, 1981.

With the exception of the postal rates contained in this Bulletin, the international postal rates and fees published in Special Postal Bulletin 21290 (3-20-81), Postal Bulletin 21301 (6-4-81) and Postal Bulletin 21305 (7-2-81) are in effect.

They are charged 55¢ for the first 2 ounces and 30¢ for each additional 2 ounces or fraction thereof.

(1) When a third-class 5-digit presort level rate mailing consists of pieces to be mailed at the basic rate, the mailer is required to provide the post office with a list of the number of qualifying pieces to each ZIP Code destination except as noted in 622.12c(2).

(2) A list of the number of qualifying pieces being mailed to each ZIP Code destination is not required when all sacks containing identical weight third-class 5-digit presort level rate pieces are physically separated at the time of mailing from all sacks containing identical weight pieces to be mailed at the basic rate.

#### IV. POSTAL STAMPS AND STATIONERY

#### **General Information**

This information pertains to the availability of stamps and postal stationery to be used in connection with postage rate changes which will become effective November 1, 1981. It is imperative that postmasters insure that all sales outlets will have a supply of the new First-Class rate postage stamps and stamped paper by the effective date. The stamps and postal stationery were printed without denomination because of the uncertainty of what the new rates would be and the production and distribution lead time required to implement the proposed postage rate change.

#### 20-Cent C Series, Regular Postage Stamps

Description. A non-denominated postage stamp with a selling value of 20 cents will first be placed on sale at Memphis, TN 38101, on October 11, 1981. This stamp is intended for domestic use only; it may not be used for international mail.

#### 20-Cent C Series Embossed Stamped Envelopes

Description. The domestic rate Robert Morris single and double (reply) postal cards will be first placed on sale at Memphis, TN 38101 on October 11, 1981. The selling value has been set at 13 cents. These cards are intended for domestic use only; they may not be used for international mail.

#### Supplies—General

Details concerning automatic distribution of each C Series item are provided below and highlighted in Exhibit A. Post offices which are not indicated in Exhibit A as receiving automatic shipments of particular items must obtain them from their Stamp Distribution Office (SDO).

Associate post offices may have already been advised to submit a Form 17, Stamp Requisition, to their SDO for a sixty-day supply of required items. Post offices which have not already done so must immediately submit such a Form 17 to their respective SDO.

Envelopes and postal cards will be ordered from SDO's in standard full pack quantities (multiples of 500 envelopes or 250 postal cards). Sheet stamps will be ordered in full packages of 10,000 as far as practical. All items will be requisitioned on a single Form 17.

#### C Series Stamps

The C Series stamps are being distributed differently from previous non denominated issues. Associate post offices receiving 5,000-45,000 commemorative stamps through automatic distribution directly from the Bureau of Engraving and Printing (BEP) will not receive C stamps automatically. Automatic distribution of C Series sheet, book, and coil stamps is being made only to Stamp Distribution Offices (SDO's) and those post offices which received 50,000 or more new issue commemorative stamps through automatic distribution from BEP in June 1981. Exhibit B shows the approximate quantities of C Series stamps being distributed automatically to SDO's and selected post offices as described above.

Additional supplies of C Series stamps in sheets, books, and coils are available from BEP. Post offices with over 949 revenue units may order supplemental quantities of the stamps, using Form 3356, Stamp Requisition—Bulk Quantities. Other offices should requisition the items from their designated SDO.

There are no SSPC vending machine booklets of C Series stamps.

#### 1-Cent, 2-Cent, and 13-Cent Stamps

All post offices which are currently on the automatic distribution program at the Bureau of Engraving and Printing will receive an automatic distribution of 1-cent, 2-cent, and 13-cent stamps. Stamp Distribution Offices will receive a quantity of 2-cent sheet stamps (item 002) approximately eight times the number of 50-subject commemorative stamps normally received, excluding four position stock, in two equal shipments. Other offices which receive automatic distribution from BEP will receive a quantity approximately two times the number of commemorative stamps normally received. All of the above offices will also receive a shipment of 1-cent (item 001) and 13-cent (item 513) sheet stamps in approxi-

mately the same quantity of stamps automatically furnished on a 50-subject commemorative stamp.

Other post offices will submit a Form 17 to their SDO for a supply of 1-cent, 2-cent, and 13-cent stamps.

Adequate supplies of 1-cent, 2-cent, and 13-cent stamps will be available to all post offices. Post offices with over 949 revenue units may order additional supplies of these stamps from BEP, using Form 3356. All other associate post offices should requisition these stamps from their SDO's.

All post offices with over 949 revenue units requiring coils of 1-cent, 2-cent, and 13-cent stamps should immediately submit a Form 3356 to BEP. Coil stamps available from BEP are:

Each of the above items will be shipped to post offices as fast as production and distribution facilities permit.

#### C Series Embossed Stamped Envelopes

C Series plain stamped envelopes will be furnished automatically only to the SDO's.

Associate post offices which have not already done so will immediately submit a Form 17 to the SDO for a 60-day supply of C Series envelopes. The requisitions must be for a minimum 500 envelopes, and additional quantities must be in multiples of 500.

Selling prices and item numbers for the C Series envelopes are shown in Exhibit C.

There will be no banded C Series envelopes for post office self-service multi-commodity vending machines.

Requisitioning C Series Embossed Stamped Envelopes. Additional supplies of C Series envelopes are not available from the Stamped Envelope Agency. Requisition additional stocks of stamped envelopes as follows: (a) associate post offices—requisition from your designated stamp distribution offices—requisition from your regional accountable paper depository. These requisitioning instructions are effective until the availability of the new 20-cent embossed stamped envelopes is announced. Postmasters are cautioned not to place requisitions for excessive quantities.

#### Domestic Rate Robert Morris Postal Cards

Single Cut Cards. All post offices which are on the automatic distribution program at the Bureau of Engraving and Printing will receive a supply of the domestic rate cut single postal card item 213 directly from the Government Printing Office. The quantity of cards being fur-

nished automatically is equal to the quantity of stamps supplied on a 50-subject commemorative postage stamp. All other post offices should immediately requisition (using Form 17) a 6-week supply of the Robert Morris cut postal cards directly from their Stamp Distribution Office.

Sheet and Reply Cards. Robert Morris postal cards in sheet and reply form are available only at regional accountable paper depositories. However, since only Stamp Distribution Offices may order stock from accountable paper depositories, all post offices requiring Robert Morris sheet or reply postal cards must order them on Form 17 through their Stamp Distribution Office, using item 211 for sheet cards and item 212 for reply cards. Requisitions for sheet postal cards must be submitted for minimum lots of 10,000 cards and multiples thereof. Requisitions for reply cards must be submitted for quantities of 250; 500; 1,000; 2,000; 5,000; and multiples of 5,000.

#### **Printed Stamped Envelopes**

Postmasters may accept customer requests for stamped envelopes with return addresses. Orders must be for minimum lots of 500. Allow 6 weeks for delivery. Selling prices for printed stamped envelopes appear in Exhibit D. The design for these envelopes will be announced in a future Postal Bulletin. Orders for printed C Series stamped envelopes will not be accepted.

#### Supplies for Self-Service Post Offices

The availability of new rate vending machine stamp booklets, banded postal cards, banded stamped envelopes, and insurance booklets for post offices having multi-commodity vending machines will be announced in a future POSTAL BULLETIN.

#### C Stamps and Embossed Envelopes

The nondenominated C postage stamps in sheet, booklet and coil forms, and the nondenominated C envelope will be placed on sale October 11 in Memphis, Tennessee. The value of the stamps and envelopes is 20 cents; the new First-Class postage rate is effective November 1, 1981. The C postage items are intended for domestic use only.

Procedures for ordering first day covers are as follows:

Customers are urged to buy stamps and affix them to their own covers. All covers must be addressed on the right side of envelopes at least 5/ of an inch up from the bottom. Insert a filler in each envelope and mail them to: "Customer Affixed Envelopes, Postmaster, Memphis, TN 38101-9991" by November 25. This is an extension of 30 calendar days beyond the normal 15day period for a total of 45 days. There is no charge. Uncanceled postage stamps issued prior to the date of issuance of the C stamps may be affixed to covers in addition to the C stamps. However, stamps issued after the issue date of the C stamps may not be affixed to customerprepared envelopes. Covers bearing stamps issued after the first day of issue for the C stamps will not be serviced.

9992." The cost is 20 cents for each stamp to be affixed to covers, and orders must clearly indicate whether sheet stamps, coil stamps or booklet panes are desired. Only full booklet panes of 10 stamps removed from booklets will be affixed and canceled. Personal checks in the exact amount will be accepted for orders up to the limit of 50 covers. Postage stamps and cash are unacceptable as payment.

Requests for ordering stamped envelopes should be addressed to: "C Stamped Envelopes, Postmaster, Memphis, Tennessee 38101-9991" and must be postmarked by November 25. The cost is 24 conts per envelope (20 cents for postage and 4 cents for the envelope) and the remittance procedures described above should be followed. Both sizes of regular envelopes may be ordered, but the Number 634 envelope will be provided unless the Number 10 envelope is requested. Window envelopes will not be provided.

To eliminate the requirement for Postal Service personnel to apply return addresses and to expedite processing of orders, customers are requested to send self-addressed envelopes of an appropriate size or return address labels with their orders.

# Robert Morris Postal Card (Patriots Postal Card Series)

Robert Morris, the principal financier of the American Revolution, is the subject of the latest postal card in the Patriots Series. The card will be issued in Memphis, Tennessee on October 11.

The card bears no denomination because of the uncertainty about proposed new postage rates at the time it had to be put into production. The price of the card is 13 cents, corresponding to the new postal card rate effective November 1, 1981. The nondenominated card will be succeeded by another Robert Morris card of the same design, but bearing the 13-cent denomination.


Robert Morris was an American merchant, banker and patriot and one of two men who signed all three of the country's basic documents—The Declaration of Independence, the Articles of Confederation, and the U.S. Constitution. Morris was named Superintendent of Finance by the Continental Congress in 1778, as well as agent of marine at the same time. He is credited with securing the funds which made it

possible for General Washington to move his army to Yorktown, thereby forcing the surrender of Lord Cornwallis which led to the winning of the war.

Procedures for ordering first day cancellations are as follows:

Customers desiring first day cancellations should address orders to "Patriot Postal Card, Postmaster, Memphis, TN 38101-9992." The cost is 13 cents per postal card. Personal checks in the exact amount will be accepted as payment for orders up to the limit of 50 covers. Postage stamps and cash are unacceptable as payment.

To eliminate the requirement for Postal Service personnel to apply return addresses and to expedite processing of orders, customers are requested to send self-addressed envelopes of an appropriate size or return address labels with their orders. Orders must be postmarked by November 25, which is an extension of 45 calendar days beyond the normal ordering date.



# V. ACCEPTANCE OF 3.5, 8.4, 9, AND 13-CENT PRECANCELED STAMPS AND 3.5-CENT EMBOSSED ENVELOPES

Precanceled 3.5-cent, 8.4-cent, 9-cent, and 13-cent stamps and 3.5-cent embossed envelopes may continue to be used for third-class bulk mailings and presort First-Class mailings until December 1, 1981, provided additional postage is paid at the time of mailing.

The difference between the value of the stamps and the amount of postage required under the current rate schedule must be paid before the mailing is accepted. The postage difference may be paid by postage meter stamps on the individual mailing pieces, or by affixing to Form 3602-PC, Statement of Mailing, Bulk Rates, adhesive postage stamps or postage meter stamps for the amount of the postage difference, rounded to the nearest full cent. Weigh room personnel must verify the computations on Form 3602-PC to assure proper additional postage is affixed and that all adhesive stamps used are canceled.

# VI. POLICIES FOR REVALUATING CARDS AND ENVELOPES BEARING STAMPS AT THE OLD RATES AND EXCHANGE OF STAMPS

## A. Envelopes and Cards Bearing Stamps at the Old Rates

Customers may revaluate envelopes or cards prepaid at the old rates by affixing postage or meter stamps sufficient to cover postage at the appropriate new rate.

#### B. Exchange of Stamps and Stamped Paper

Available quantities of new denomination postage stamps and postal cards are limited. Therefore, it is essential that postmasters encourage customers to affix adhesive stamps or use meter impressions rather than exchange stamped paper for items of the new denominations. Generally, the provisions of DMM 147 should be followed. Stamps may not be exchanged for cash.

#### C. Disposition of Stamps

Postmasters are not to destroy postage stamps which exceed needs because of the rate increase until notified to do so in a future POSTAL BULLETIN.

#### VII. POLICIES FOR HANDLING EMBOSSED PLAIN STAMPED ENVELOPES AND POSTAL CARDS

### A. Full Boxes of Envelopes and Full Packages of Postal Cards

The following items will be withdrawn from all stamp credits, stations, and branches, and returned to the main stock of the post office no earlier than November 1, 1981:

- 1. All 18-cent embossed plain stamped envelopes in full boxes of 500.
- 2. All 12-cent postal cards (cut single regular and reply) in full packages of 250.

3. All 12-cent postal cards in sheets.

These items will be held intact in the main stock until instructions are issued in a later POSTAL BULLETIN.

#### B. Less Than Full Boxes and Full Packages

Effective November 1, 1981, 18-cent embossed stamped envelopes and 12-cent postal cards in less than full boxes and full packages, will be treated as non-saleable stock and handled in accordance with subchapter 550, Fiscal Handbook F-1, Financial Handbook for Post Offices.

#### VIII. C STAMP POSTER

All post offices will receive by October 10 ample quantities of the 8½" x 11" C stamp notice, which pictures the C stamp and indicates its value will be 20 cents. This notice, similar to those issued for the A and B stamps,

should be posted on October 13 at entrances to post offices, stations and branches and in other prominent places in lobbies in such a way as to insure all customers read it. See poster on page 29.
