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## 36-Cent DC-3 Airmail Postal Card

The 36-cent DC-3 Airmail postal card goes on sale May 14, 1988, in San Diego, California

**Do Not Sell Before May 16, 1988**



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Collector information is on page 29.

**Supply.** Only post offices with philatelic centers will receive an automatic distribution. All other post offices should order sufficient quantities of this postal card to meet anticipated local philatelic demand.

CAG A-G post offices requiring bulk quantities should immediately submit Form 3216, *Requisition for Postal Cards—Bulk Quantities*, to the Government Printing Office (GPO) using *item 256*. The GPO will convert unfilled requisitions for 33-cent airmail postal cards currently at the GPO to the 36-cent DC-3 Airmail postal card.

All other post offices should immediately order cards from their stamp distribution offices on a separate Form 17-A, *Accountable Items Requisition from Stamp Distribution Office*.

## Blood Specimens Prohibited: Canada

Canada Post Corporation has reported receiving blood specimens in mail shipments from the United States. Postal employees must know that Canada prohibits perishable infectious and noninfectious biological substances in mail shipments, including blood specimens.

To ensure proper acceptance of international mail, postal employees should always check the individual Country Listing in the INTERNATIONAL MAIL MANUAL.

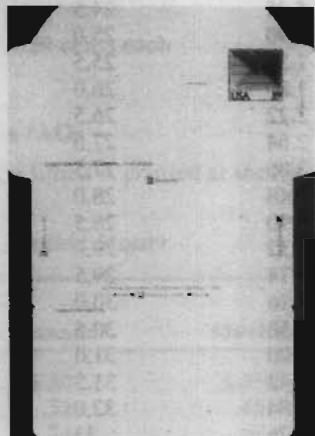

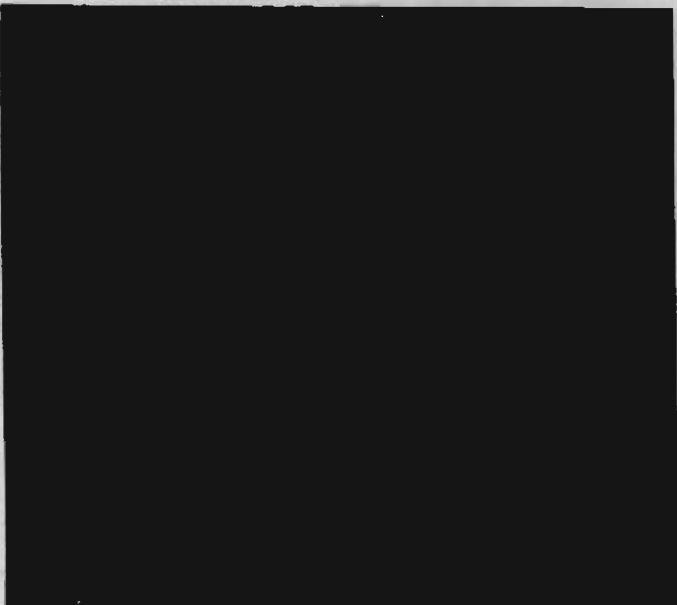
**Supply:** Only post offices with authorized philatelic centers will receive an automatic distribution. Those post offices should requisition additional aerogrammes for their regular window transactions. All other post offices should order sufficient quantities to meet philatelic demand. The automatic distribution is based on the bureau of Engraving and Printing's four-position schedule for a 50-subject commemorative stamp. Accordingly, the quantities of aerogrammes offices will receive follow:

| Offices receiving four-position stock in these quantities | Will receive aerogrammes in these quantities |

| 25,000 to 50,000.....                                     | 500  |

All CAG A-G offices requiring these aerogrammes in the standard bulk ordering quantities should immediately submit Forms 3356, *Stamp Requisition—Bulk Quantities* (using *Item 236*), to the Bureau of Engraving and Printing. All other post offices requiring these aerogrammes in less-than-bulk quantities should requisition them immediately from their designated Stamp Distribution Offices on separate Forms 17-A, *Accountable Items Requisition from Stamp Distribution Office*.

**Note:** Due to the thickness of a new type of paper used for this issue, offices will not receive aerogrammes in full cartons of 1,000 or 5,000 at this time. Offices requiring 1,000 will receive two cartons of 500. Offices requiring 5,000 will receive one carton of 4,000 plus two cartons of 500.

### Military Leave: Processing Requests

The correction to the article Military Leave: Processing Requests, in POSTAL BULLETIN 21668, 4-14-88 (page 2), omitted the last sentence of the corrected paragraph. The complete text follows:

*Military Leave for Law Enforcement.* If a leave request is for law enforcement purposes, installations must submit a memorandum to the PDC requesting advancement of military leave for law enforcement purposes for the number of hours requested, not to exceed 176 hours for a full-time employee or, for a part-time employee, the number of hours of law enforcement leave to which the employee is entitled, as shown in the AAD935P4 report. If regular military leave has not been advanced, follow the procedures in Regular Military Leave above.

### Mislabeled BBM Sacks for Idaho

The Western Region reports that Pocatello, Idaho, is continuing to receive Bulk Business Mail (BBM) sacks from mailers nationally.

The State Distribution Center (SDC) for Idaho was relocated from DIS Pocatello ID 832 to DIS Boise ID 836, effective April 15, 1987. This mislabeling is creating serious delays in the SDC distribution at Boise ID.

Offices must destroy any DIS Pocatello ID 832 labels in their possession and immediately replace them with DIS Boise ID 836.

## PERMANENT INTERNATIONAL RATES AND FEES

Pursuant to its authority under 39 U.S.C. 407, the Postal Service announces permanent adjustments in international postal rates and in fees for special mail services as indicated below. These rates and fees for special mail services are effective at 12:01 a.m., April 17, 1988. The interim rates and fees implemented on April 3, 1988 (see Special Postal Bulletin 21666, 3-25-88, pages 52-63), are canceled at the same time the permanent rates below become effective. (Note: The permanent rates and fees are unchanged from the interim rates and fees.)

## Flag With Clouds Regular Stamp

The 25-cent Flag With Clouds sheet stamp will be issued May 6 in Boxborough, Massachusetts. The stamp becomes available at post offices nationwide on the next business day. The official dedication ceremony will be at the Sheraton Boxborough in conjunction with Philatelic Show '88.

The gravure-printed Flag With Clouds replaces the 22-cent Flag With Fireworks sheet stamp. Like its predecessor, the stamp's full-color design is a reflection of the Postal Service's intention to use brighter colors on many regular issues expected to receive widespread use.

The Postal Service will issue a booklet version of the Flag With Clouds stamp at a future date. Procedures for ordering first day cancellations follow:

**Customers Affixing Stamps:** The Postal Service encourages customers to purchase the Flag With Clouds stamps and affix them to their envelopes. Covers

bearing stamps receive preferential service. They should address envelopes on the right side at least  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch from the bottom and affix stamps in the upper right corner approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch from the top and right edges. Orders must be postmarked by July 5 and addressed: Customer-Affixed Envelopes, Flag With Clouds Stamp, Postmaster, Boxborough, MA 01719-9991. The Postal Service requires no remittance.

**Postal Service Affixing Stamps:** Except for affixing stamps and addressing orders, follow the procedures above. The price is 25 cents per stamp requested, and the Postal Service accepts personal checks in the exact amount up to the limit of 50 envelopes. Customers should not send cash or postage stamps as payment. Orders must be postmarked by July 5 and addressed: Flag With Clouds Stamp, Postmaster, Boxborough, MA 01719-9992.

The 45-cent Samuel Pierpont Langley airmail postage stamp goes on sale May 14, 1988, in San Diego, California. Langley, an astronomer, architect, physicist, and early airplane experimenter, was named Secretary to the Smithsonian Institution in 1887. During his tenure, he established the Astrophysical Observatory and the National Zoological Park. His turn-of-the-century experiments in mechanical flight provided groundwork and inspiration for the Wright brothers, Glenn Curtiss, and many others. Langley's inventions include the unmanned Aerodrome #5, the first American heavier-than-air flying machine to make a free flight of any significant length—on May 6, 1896.

**Supply.** Only post offices with authorized philatelic centers will receive automatic distribution. *All other post offices must order sufficient quantities to meet philatelic demand.*

**Bulk Quantities.** CAG A-G post offices requiring 25,000 or more stamps should immediately submit Form 3356, *Stamp Requisition—Bulk Quantities*, to the Bureau of Engraving and Printing, using *item 574*. They must submit requisitions in the following quantities: 25,000; 50,000; 75,000; 100,000; 125,000 to the maximum ordering quantity of 1,000,000 stamps.

The Bureau will convert unfilled requisitions for the 44-cent Transpacific Airmail stamp currently at the Bureau to the 45-cent Samuel Pierpont Langley Airmail stamp.

**Less-Than-Bulk Quantities.** All other post offices requiring fewer than 25,000 stamps should requisition them immediately from their designated stamp distribution office on a separate Form 17-A, *Accountable Items Requisitioned from Stamp Distribution Office—Philatelic and Retail Services Dept., 4-21-88*.

Enter the effective date of the fee. *Note:* If your version of Form 3636-G is dated October 1987 or earlier, you must modify the portion of the form titled "Fee Year": instead of writing the last two digits of the fee year (for example, "89" for 1989), you must write the effective date of the assessment using an mm/dd/yy format (for example, 01-01-89, if you are renewing existing fees, or the date the fee is assessed for new fees).

#### 245.2 Requirements for Mailing Statements

a. Form 3602, *Statement of Mailing with Permit Imprints*. This mailing statement is used with nonzone rated mailings at either bulk rates or single piece rates. All pieces must be of identical weight and the same rate category (Exhibit 245.2a). *Note:* If your version of Form 3602 is dated April 1985 or earlier and you have a ZIP + 4 barcoded mailing, check the block titled "Other" under "Mail Category" and write "(First- or third-class) ZIP + 4 barcoded."

b. Form 3605, *Statement of Mailing—Bulk Zone Rates*. This mailing statement is used with zone rated mailings of fourth-class mail (either single piece or bulk rate) and for mailings of Priority Mail. All pieces must be of identical weight and for the same rate category. The pieces must be separated by zone upon presentation to the post office (Exhibit 245.2b).

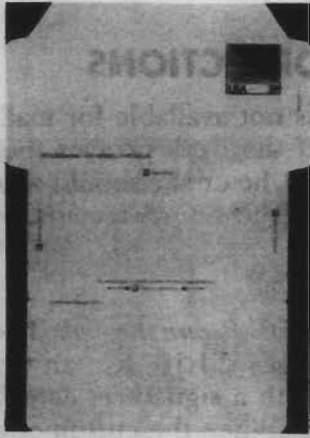

## 39-Cent Regular Aerogramme

A 39-cent regular aerogramme will be issued on May 9 in Miami, Florida. There will be no dedication ceremony, but the Postal Service will offer first-day cancellations and has extended the standard deadline an additional 30 days to allow customers to send requests.

The aerogramme design by Uldis Purins incorporates an appropriate graphic—the stylized image of an envelope. Horizontal lines in gradient shades of orange, red, purple, blue, and green form the familiar envelope folds.

The Postal Service is using a standard, noncommemorative design for this item in response to customer requests for such an aerogramme. The standard format allows substantially more writing space.

*Customer Providing Stationery:* The Postal Service encourages customers to purchase the 39-cent standard aerogramme at post offices or philatelic centers and

submit it for cancellation. Customers who provide their own items receive preferential service. Customers must fold aerogrammes properly and address them on the right side at least 5/8 inch from the bottom. Peelable return address labels are acceptable. Requests for the aerogramme must be postmarked by July 8 and addressed: Customer-Provided Stationery, 39-Cent Regular Aerogramme, Postmaster, Miami, FL 33152-9991. The Postal Service requires no remittance.

*Postal Service Providing Stationery:* The Postal Service will also supply the aerogramme if requested. Customers should provide a peelable return address label. The price is 39 cents each, and the Postal Service accepts personal checks in the exact amount up to the limit of 50 aerogrammes. Customers should not send cash or postage stamps. Orders must be postmarked by July 8 and addressed: 39-Cent Regular Aerogramme, Postmaster, Miami, FL 33152-9992.

## All Offices With IRTs

**INTEGRATED RETAIL TERMINAL RATE CORRECTIONS**

The April 3, 1988, update disks for both the UNISYS Integrated Retail Terminal (IRT), version 3.00, and the MOS IRT, version 1.20, contain incorrect rates. Offices must post the following information at every IRT window position to ensure proper rates are being charged. The next update disk for the UNISYS and MOS IRTs will correct these problems.

**UNISYS Procedures**

*First-Class/Priority Pieces Between 11 Ounces and 2 Pounds.* The UNISYS IRT incorrectly charges \$2.45, the First-Class rate, for single pieces between 11 and 12 ounces. The Priority rate of \$2.40 is the correct rate for single pieces exceeding 11 ounces and weighing not more than 2 pounds. Whenever the screen shows \$2.45 for First Class/Priority Mail, the clerk must press the Reset key, select either the Postage Stamps or Post Office Meter key, and enter \$2.40.

*Express Mail With Return Receipt.* When the customer uses Express Mail with a return receipt, do not use either of the Return Receipt keys. Press the Miscellaneous Postage key and enter \$.90 for a return receipt with a signature and date, or enter \$1.20 for a return receipt including the address where delivered.

*Merchandise Return/Return Receipt With Special Service.* The merchandise return receipt service is only available for Priority, third- and fourth-class mail and should not be added to First-Class Mail. A

return receipt is not available for mail insured for \$50 and less. If the clerk presses the Return Receipt key in error, he or she should depress it again and the rate for the return receipt will disappear from the screen.

**MOS Procedures**

*Express Mail With Return Receipt.* The MOS IRT incorrectly charges \$1.10 for an Express Mail return receipt with a signature, date, and address where delivered. When the customer requests Express Mail with this service, the clerk must not use the Return Receipt with Address key. The clerk must select the Stamps key and enter \$1.20 to obtain the correct required postage.

*Express Mail for Great Britain.* The International Express Mail rate for Great Britain is not correct for any Express Mail pieces weighing more than 1 (1.00 or above on screen) pound. To obtain the correct rate for this country, the clerk must refer to the chart in the Special POSTAL BULLETIN 21666, 3-25-88 (page 57).

*Merchandise Return/Return Receipt With Special Service.* The merchandise return receipt service is only available for Priority, third-, and fourth-class mail and should not be added to First-Class Mail. A return receipt is not available for mail insured for \$50 and less. If the clerk presses the Return Receipt key in error, he or she should depress it again and the rate for the return receipt will disappear from the screen.—Dept. of the Controller, 4-21-88.

**INTERNATIONAL REGISTERED MAIL**

All employees who accept international registered mail should review the acceptance procedures in INTERNATIONAL MAIL MANUAL (IMM) 334. Specifically, acceptance employees must affix Label 200, *Registered Mail*, to the item in the lower left corner of the address side. They must also postmark registered letters twice on the back, on the crossing of the upper and lower flap, and make the

postmark legible. Additionally, personnel should ensure that the complete address of the sender, including ZIP Code, is in the upper left corner of the address side of the item.

Personnel must follow the procedures in IMM 334 to ensure proper handling and accountability in the destination country.

## Samuel P. Langley Airmail Stamp

The 45-cent Samuel P. Langley airmail stamp will be issued on May 4 in San Diego, California. The dedication ceremony, in conjunction with the DC-3 postal card, will be at Brown Field, the site of Air/Space America, the largest aerospace trade exposition yet presented in the United States.

The stamp design by Ken Dallison illustrates one of Langley's inventions, the unmanned Aerodrome #5, the first American heavier-than-air flying machine to make a free flight of any significant length (on May 6, 1896).

**Customers Affixing Stamps:** The Postal Service encourages customers to purchase the Langley stamps and affix them to their envelopes. Covers bearing stamps receive preferential service. They should address envelopes on the right side at least  $\frac{5}{8}$  inch from the bottom and affix stamps in the upper right corner approximately  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch from the top and right edges. Orders must be postmarked

by June 13 and addressed: Customer-Affixed Envelopes, Samuel P. Langley Stamp, Postmaster, San Diego, CA 92199-9991.

**Postal Service Affixing Stamps:** Except for affixing stamps and addressing orders, follow the procedures above. The price is 45 cents per stamp requested, and the Postal Service accepts personal checks in the exact amount up to the limit of 50 envelopes. Customers should not send cash or postage stamps. Orders must be postmarked by June 13 and addressed: Samuel P. Langley Stamp, Postmaster, San Diego, CA 92199-9992.

**Combination Cancellations:** Customers also may choose to have the Postal Service affix the Samuel P. Langley stamp to the DC-3 postal card. The price for combination cancellations is 81 cents. Orders must be postmarked by June 13 and addressed: Combination Langley/DC-3 Cancellations, Postmaster, San Diego, CA 92199-9611.

## DC-3 Airmail Postal Card

The Postal Service will issue the 36-cent DC-3 postal card on May 14 in San Diego, California. The dedication ceremony, in conjunction with the Samuel P. Langley stamp, will be at Brown Field, the site of Air/Space America, the largest aerospace trade exposition yet presented in the United States.

The postal card commemorates perhaps the most successful airplane of all time, the Douglas DC-3. The aircraft represented a near flawless culmination of early aeronautic engineering and a sleekly beautiful bridge to the modern era of commercial aviation.

*Customers Providing Stationery:* The Postal Service encourages customers to purchase the postal card at post offices and philatelic centers. Customers who provide their own postal cards will receive preferential service. They should address cards on the right side at least 5/8 of an inch from the bottom. Customers may also affix uncanceled postage stamps issued before March 14. The Postal Service will return unserviced cards bearing

stamps issued after that date. Requests for cancellations on the DC-3 postal card must be postmarked by June 13 and addressed: Customer-Provided Postal Cards, Postmaster, San Diego, CA 92199-9613.

*Postal Service Providing Stationery:* Customers should provide a peelable return address label for each postal card. The price is 36 cents each, and the Postal Service accepts personal checks in the exact amount up to the limit of 50 items. Customers should not send cash or postage stamps. Orders must be postmarked by June 13 and addressed: DC-3 Postal Card, Postmaster, San Diego, CA 92199-9614.

*Combination Cancellations:* Customers also may choose to have the Postal Service affix the Samuel P. Langley stamp to the DC-3 postal card. The price for combination cancellations is 81 cents. Orders must be postmarked by June 13 and addressed: Combination Langley/DC-3 Cancellations, Postmaster, San Diego, CA 92199-9611.

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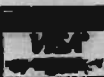
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
