25-Cent Prehistoric Animals Commemorative Stamps

The 25-cent Prehistoric Animals commemorative stamps go on sale October 1 in Orlando, Florida. The block of four stamps will kick off this year's National Stamp Collecting Month. They feature the Tyrannosaurus (tyrant lizard), Pteranodon (winged lizard), Brontosaurus (thunder lizard) (or Apatosaurus), and Stegosaurus (plated lizard) in suspended movement across sweeping natural vistas.

Supply. All post offices will receive twice their standard automatic distribution quantities for a 50-subject commemorative stamp, rounded up to the nearest packaging increment for a 40-subject stamp. *The Bureau of Engraving and Printing will not honor supplemental requisitions for Item 4466.* Printouts and invoices furnished to stamp distribution offices (SDOs) by the New York Postal Data Center will be dated for September 19. Due to the field realignment, SDOs must distribute the Prehistoric Animals stamps by September 19. They must make every effort to ensure that associate offices receive these stamps by September 22 to eliminate in-transit shipments.

Limited quantities of this stamp will be shipped to regional accountable paper depositories (RAPDs) for filling supplemental orders. SDOs requiring additional stamps may order them from their RAPDs using a separate Form 17-A, *Accountable Items Requisition From Stamp Distribution Office*. All other post offices requiring additional stamps should immediately requisition them from their SDO on a separate Form 17-A.

Form 3813-P: Receipt for Insured Mail

Many post offices have insured labels, Form 3813-P, *Receipt for Insured Mail—Domestic-International*, in stock, which were printed 10 or more years ago. The glue has deteriorated on these labels causing them to fall off mailpieces in the mailstream. Furthermore, these labels do not have OCR-A font readable by the automated equipment.

Post offices should immediately check the age of Form 3813-P labels on hand and discard all stock printed before 1982. Use only those editions that have the insured number printed in OCR-A font.

EMS—Colombia

The Colombian postal administration has reported that it has been receiving Express Mail International Service (EMS) shipments containing currency and other valuable articles. Coins, banknotes, currency notes, or securities payable to bearer; travelers checks; platinum, gold, or silver (manufactured or not); precious stones; jewelry; and other valuable articles are prohibited in all EMS shipments to Colombia.

In addition, Colombia has informed the Postal Service that certain dutiable EMS items will not be delivered to the addressee but must be picked up at the post office. For this reason, all dutiable EMS items to Colombia should include the phone number of the addressee.

NATIONAL BULK RATE MAIL VERIFICATION PROGRAM

Effective September 25, 1989, the maximum allowable presort verification percentage of error will be reduced from 10 percent to 5 percent under the National Bulk Rate Mail Verification Program. Mailings will be allowed to have up to a 5 percent error in presort and mail makeup, as identified by the sampling procedures in Handbook DM-102, *Bulk Mail Acceptance*. If the sampling shows 5 percent or more errors in the mailing, it will be rejected, and the mailer will be given the option of (1) reworking the mailing to correct the errors or (2) paying the single piece rate on the percentage of the mailing estimated to be in error.

In making this change, the Postal Service allowed a 120-day transition period that began May 22, 1989, and will end September 24, 1989. See POSTAL BULLETIN 5-11-89. During the transition period, post offices were to ensure that at least two mailings from each mailer were properly verified to identify existing errors and to notify mailers of these errors. This procedure allowed mailers sufficient lead time to correct those errors identified and to make any operational changes necessary. During the remainder of the transition period and after full implementation, mailers will be made aware of all errors found in their mailings, regardless of the percentage of error.

This change in the National Bulk Rate Mail Verification Program relates only to the reduction of the presort verification tolerance level from 10 percent to 5 percent. All other bulk mail acceptance functions remain unchanged.

Effective September 25, 1989

The transition period ends September 24, 1989. Effective September 25, 1989 all post offices par-

ticipating in the National Bulk Mail Verification Program must use the following procedures:

1. Continue to reject mailings with critical errors. These critical types of errors include but are not limited to:

- a. Insufficient postage on deposit.
- b. Postage not paid.
- c. Fees not paid.
- d. Mail containers exceeding weight limits.
- e. Nonmailable matter.
- f. Improper or missing permit imprint indicia.
- g. Mail not eligible for postage rate claimed.

2. Enforce the new error allowance of 5 percent presort failure for all mailings. That is, if a mailing contains 5 percent or more errors in presort and/or mail makeup, the mailing will be rejected, and the mailer will have the option of reworking the mailing or paying the single piece rate on the percentage of the mailing estimated to be in error.

3. If a mailing is identified as containing less than 5 percent in errors in presort and/or mail makeup, provide the customer with written documentation Form 2866, *Presort Verification Record* of the errors found and provide assistance, as necessary, on proper preparation. This assistance will enable mailers to further improve the quality of presort and mail makeup as well as their mail operations.

This change in the National Bulk Mail Verification Program will not affect those mailers with effective quality control in their mailing operations and who submit properly prepared mailings. However, mailers submitting mailings improperly prepared will clearly need to resolve existing problems to meet Postal Service requirements for acceptance.

A future revision to Chapter 9, Handbook DM-102 *Bulk Mail Acceptance*, will include this change.

Philadelphia City Postal Card

An America the Beautiful Series postal card, honoring the city of Philadelphia, will be issued there on September 25. The dedication ceremony will be held in Congress Hall at Independence National Historical Park.

The postal card, designed by Bart Forbes, features a horizontal aerial view of Independence Hall, where many of the documents dramatizing America's growth from a fledgling string of colonies to a worldwide superpower were created and signed.

Home to the convention that approved the Bill of Rights, Philadelphia is the first of four cities to be honored on America the Beautiful Series postal cards. Baltimore, New York, and Washington, DC, will be featured on three separate cards this fall. The cities were selected to highlight those places that might easily be visited by delegates to the Universal Postal Union Congress, convening in the nation's capital in November.

Procedures for ordering first-day cancellations follow.

Customers Providing Stationery. As the Philadelphia City postal card may not be available at some post offices, the Postal Service recommends that customers purchase the cards from philatelic centers or by mail order from the Philatelic Sales Division, referencing Item 2226.

Customers who provide their own cards receive

preferential service. They should address cards at least $\frac{1}{8}$ inch from the bottom. Customers may also affix uncanceled stamps issued on or before September 25, 1989. The Postal Service will return unserviced cards bearing stamps issued after that date. Requests must be postmarked by October 25 and addressed: Customer-Provided Stationery, Postmaster, Philadelphia, PA 19104-9991. No remittance is required.

Postal Service Providing Stationery. Customers should provide a peelable return label for each postal card. The price is 15 cents per card, and the Postal Service accepts personal checks in the exact amount up to the limit of 50 items. Customers should not send cash or postage stamps. Orders must be postmarked by October 25 and addressed: Philadelphia City Postal Card, Postmaster, Philadelphia, PA 19104-9992.

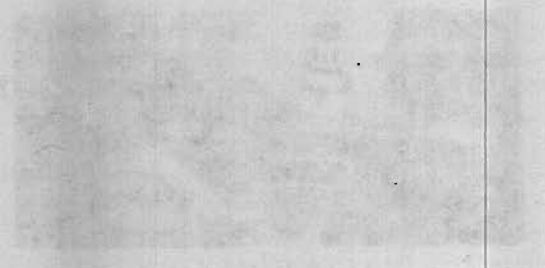
Combination Cancellations. Customers also may choose to have the Postal Service affix the Drafting of the Bill of Rights stamp—which is also being issued September 25 in Philadelphia—to the Philadelphia City postal card and apply a single first-day cancellation. The price for combination cancellations is 40 cents each. Orders must be postmarked by October 25 and addressed: Combination Cover, Philadelphia City Postal Card and Bill of Rights Stamp, Postmaster, Philadelphia, PA 19104-9992.

Prehistoric Animals Commemorative Stamps

To kick off this year's Stamp Collecting Month, a block of four 25-cent commemorative stamps showing earth's great prehistoric animals will be issued October 1 in Orlando, Florida. Postmaster General Anthony M. Frank will speak at the first day of issue dedication ceremony at the Universe of Energy Exhibit in EPCOT Center, World Disney World.

Designed by illustrator and muralist, John Gurche, the stamps show the Tyrannosaurus (tyrant lizard), Pteranodon (winged lizard), Brontosaurus (thunder lizard) (or Apatosaurus), and Stegosaurus (plated lizard) in suspended movement across sweeping natural vistas. Gurche is known for his realistic depictions of prehistoric animals in *National Geographic* and at the Museum of Natural History in Washington, DC.

Appearing at about the same time as the first mammals, these ancient beasts are thought to have inhabited the earth for approximately 140 million years, before disappearing under circumstances still debated.

Although now recognized by the scientific community as Apatosaurus, the name Brontosaurus was used for the stamp because it is more familiar to the general population. Similarly, the term dinosaur has been used generically to describe all the ani-

mals, even though the Pteranodon was a flying reptile.

Procedures for ordering first-day cancellations follow.

Customers Affixing Stamps. The Postal Service encourages customers to purchase the Prehistoric Animals stamps and affix them to their envelopes. Covers bearing stamps receive preferential service. Customers should address envelopes 5/8 inch from the bottom and affix stamps 1/4 inch from the top and right edges. Requests must be postmarked by October 31 and addressed: Customer Affixed Envelopes, Prehistoric Animals Stamps, Postmaster, Orlando, FL 32862-9991. No remittance is required.

Postal Service Affixing Stamps. Except for affixing stamps and addressing orders, follow the procedures above. The price is 25 cents per cover, and the Postal Service accepts personal checks in the exact amount up to the limit of 50 envelopes. Customers should not send cash or postage stamps. Orders must be postmarked by October 31 and addressed: Prehistoric Animals Stamps, Postmaster, Orlando, FL 32862-9992.

The first day of issue cancellations will read: Lake Buena Vista, FL 32830, which is the station of the Orlando Post Office that serves EPCOT Center.

After offices deplete local stocks of the item, it will be available from all philatelic centers and by mail order from the Philatelic Sales Division for approximately 1 year. A *Philatelic Catalog*, listing all available stamps and other philatelic items, is available here or from the Philatelic Sales Division, Washington, DC 20265-9997.
