Arrow Lock Removal

In some geographic areas, Arrow locks are not being removed from abandoned buildings that are scheduled to be torn down or remodeled. Leaving Arrow locks in abandoned buildings jeopardizes the USPS security system for mail deposited in collection boxes, apartment house mail receptacles, parcel lockers, neighborhood delivery and collection box units (NDCBUs), as well as the security of relay boxes and key-keepers.

Postmasters should instruct carriers to report locations where Arrow locks may be recovered from uninhabited buildings that are being razed or remodeled. Use Form 3521, *House Numbers and Mail Receptacles Report*, or Form 1621, *Delivery Management Report*, for this purpose. Promptly remove the Arrow locks from these buildings. (See requirements in Publication 17, *Apartment House Mail Receptacles—Regulations and Manufacturing Standards*.)

APO/FPO ZIP Code Alignment

The APO/FPO table entitled Conditions Applied to Mail Addressed to Post Offices Overseas on page 21, reflects a crosswalk of old to new ZIP Codes. The Postal Service implemented the APO/FPO ZIP Code alignment and address standardization programs on July 15, 1991, as part of the Military Mail Improvement Initiatives. A similar crosswalk of old to new APO/FPO ZIP Codes is in production for integrated retail terminals (IRTs) and should be ready for the field in July.

Refer to *Postal Bulletin* 21798, 9-19-91 (page 15), for the one-page information chart, APO/FPO ZIP Code Alignment and Address Standardization. An additional delivery line designation of CMR (and number) has been approved. Previously approved delivery line designations of UNIT (and number) and PSC (and number), plus BOX (and number) if boxes are assigned, or ship name, are in use.

All mailers and military customers are urged to begin using the new address format and ZIP Code now. The old address format and ZIP Code ends February 15, 1993. Until then, the Postal Service accepts both old and new addresses. However, Address Information Systems (AIS) products will reflect only the standardized military addresses as of September 15, 1992.

Free Mail—Reminder

Free Mail from troops associated with Operations Desert Shield/Storm is still in effect. Military personnel authorized this privilege may mail without postage letters, postcards, and audio or video tapes having the character of personal correspondence to any place within the United States, or possessions or territories of the United States.

Free mail must have a complete APO or FPO return address, the word *FREE* in the right-hand corner with an APO or FPO postmark, and a complete delivery address.

Do not collect postage on delivery or return this mail to the sender for postage. All employees involved with the delivery of mail should know about this program.

Simplified Address Format

Questions exist about whether or not the city, state, and ZIP Code are required when using one of the designated forms of the simplified address format in *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) 122.412b (postal customer, residential customer, or business customer).

Effective with DMM Issue 44 (9-20-92), 122.412a is revised as follows:

122.412 City Routes and Post Office Boxholders

a. The addressee's name, street address or post office box number and city, state, and ZIP Code may be omitted from the address . . . (the remainder of the sentence is unchanged).

FLEXIBLE SPENDING ACCOUNTS OPEN SEASON

The open season for the new Health Care and Dependent Care Flexible Spending Accounts (FSAs) for career nonbargaining-unit employees is June 1 through June 26, 1992, for the coverage period July 1 through December 31, 1992. FSAs provide pretax savings opportunities for employees with certain types of health and dependent care expenses. This article describes FSA open season materials and personnel office processing responsibilities. FSA plan features are fully described in an employee brochure that will be mailed to all eligible employees at their address of record during the first week of June. The Travelers Insurance Company will administer FSAs.

Election Opportunities

Two FSAs. Eligible career nonbargaining-unit employees may elect to enroll in either or both of two FSAs—a Health Care FSA and a Dependent Care FSA—for the coverage period July 1 through December 31, 1992. Each FSA covers eligible expenses incurred between those dates. Eligible expenses and guidelines for estimating future expenses are described in the brochure being mailed.

Contribution Levels. Eligible employees may elect to contribute maximums of \$1,300 to a Health Care FSA and \$2,500 to a Dependent Care FSA in 1992. The amount an employee elects to contribute is withheld in equal amounts from paychecks for 13 pay periods (PP), PP 15-92 through PP 27-92 (pay dates July 17 through December 31, 1992). The minimum contribution for employees who elect to participate is \$65 per FSA—\$5 per pay period. Employees who elect both FSAs, thus, must contribute a total minimum of \$10 per pay period.

Future Election Opportunities. There will be another open season beginning in November 1992 for enrollment for calendar year 1993. For calendar year 1993, maximum contribution limits increase to \$2,600 for a Health Care FSA and \$5,000 for a Dependent Care FSA (\$2,500 for a married employee filing a separate return). Employees must make a new FSA election each open season to continue participation.

Enrollment Processing

Personnel offices that are Distributed Data Entry/Distributed Reporting (DDE/DR) sites are responsible for entering enrollment data into the DDE/DR computer system. Personnel offices that are not DDE/DR sites forward valid FSA enrollment forms to their DDE/DR site for processing. Elections received from June 1 through June 24, 1992, are processed using the DDE/DR system's FSA open season screen. (System users will receive FSA DDE/DR instructions.) FSA enrollment forms received from June 25 through June 26, 1992, are processed as part of the regular on-line file mainte-

nance (OFM) system. These must be processed *no later than July 8, 1992*, to be effective PP 15-92.

Eligibility

Career nonbargaining-unit employees who have or will have completed 26 full pay periods of career service by the end of PP 14-92 (June 26, 1992) may elect to enroll in an FSA. However, employees who have been in a leave without pay (LWOP) status that has lasted for more than eight consecutive full pay periods by the end of PP 14-92 are ineligible to elect FSA coverage.

Effective Date

FSA enrollments received during this open season are effective with PP 15-92. Employees must submit their FSA enrollment forms for this open season to their personnel office no later than June 26, 1992. Once processed, enrollments cannot be changed or canceled during the plan period (July 1 through December 31, 1992) except following qualified life status changes, which are explained in the employee brochure.

Open Season Materials

Enrollment Kit. During the first week of June, Travelers will mail an FSA enrollment kit to all career nonbargaining-unit employees at their mailing address of record. Career nonbargaining-unit employees who have not received an enrollment kit by June 5 should request the information from their personnel office. Enrollment kits contain (1) an employee brochure, FSA BK1, *Flexible Spending Account, Plan Period: July 1 through December 31, 1992* (May 1992); (2) Form 8200, *Flexible Spending Account Enrollment Form* (May 1992); (3) FSA1, *Flexible Spending Account (FSA) Withdrawal Request* (May 1992); and (4) FSA2, *Tax Information for Flexible Spending Accounts* (May 1992). The employee brochure contains policies and plan provisions as well as a question and answer section for easy reference. The enrollment form is used to elect FSA coverage. The withdrawal request form is used by FSA participants to request reimbursements from their accounts for expenses incurred during the plan period. The tax information sheet explains certain tax regulations that apply to FSAs. Employees who elect to participate in one or both FSAs must return a completed enrollment form to their personnel office no later than June 26, 1992.

Distribution of Materials. Travelers is distributing a small stock of the enrollment kits, an FSA videotape, an administration manual, and FSA posters to field divisions, management sectional centers (MSCs), bulk mail centers (BMCs), Headquarters (HQ), and HQ field units. Replacement copies of the Form 8200 enrollment form, the FSA1 withdrawal request, the FSA BK1 employee brochure,

or the FSA2 tax information sheet may be requisitioned from the materiel distribution centers (MDCs) using Form 7380, *MDC Supply Requisition*.

FSA Videotape. The FSA videotape introduces the concept of FSAs. It provides no open season information or program details. Personnel offices may use the videotape to acquaint eligible employees with FSAs during open season and throughout the year. Employees who view the videotape should be referred to the employee brochure and other FSA materials for more detailed information. The FSA videotape is scheduled for distribution on June 1, 1992. Field divisions, MSCs, BMCs, HQ, and HQ field units will receive two copies of the videotape, one for single play use and one, suitable for health fairs, that plays continuously.

Caution: Examples used in the videotape convey potential *full-year* benefits for employees. For 1992, the plan period is only a half-year. Beginning in 1993, the FSA coverage period is a full year, January 1 through December 31, with a maximum health care FSA contribution of \$2,600 and a maximum dependent care FSA contribution of \$5,000. Since the 1992 coverage period is 6 months (from July 1 through December 31, 1992) the maximum contribution levels are limited to \$1,300 and \$2,500 for Health Care and Dependent Care FSAs, respectively. Personnel offices must introduce the tape by reminding employees that examples used in the videotape convey full-year maximum benefits, while the limitations imposed for the 1992 coverage period result in one-half the possible maximum benefits.

Administration Manual. FSA BK2, *Flexible Spending Account Administration Manual* (May 1992), is being mailed to field divisions, MSCs, BMCs, HQ, and HQ field units, and should be received by May 26, 1992. The administration manual outlines the role of personnel offices in processing enrollment forms, following FSA procedures, and maintaining appropriate records. Field divisions, MSCs, HQ, and HQ field units must ensure that subordinate installations are aware of their responsibility to verify and forward FSA enrollment forms to their DDE/DR processing site expeditiously.

FSA Posters. Installations that receive FSA posters must widely distribute and post them in locations where career nonbargaining employees are most likely to view them. These posters will alert eligible employees who did not receive the enrollment kit to request FSA information.

The table on pages 4 and 5 summarizes the distribution and personnel office action for the FSA forms, booklets, poster, and videotape discussed in this article.

Personnel Office Responsibilities

Personnel office responsibilities and processing procedures are explained in the administration manual being mailed by Travelers. These responsibilities include accepting and processing enrollment forms; determining eligibility to participate; determining eligibility to change contribution levels based upon participants' qualified life status changes; and filing Copy 1 of Form 8200 in employees' official personnel folders.

Personnel offices must ensure that FSAs are covered in the benefits information provided to employees promoted or reassigned from a bargaining-unit or noncareer position to a career nonbargaining-unit position.

Personnel offices do not process employee withdrawal request forms (which are mailed directly to Travelers at the address shown on the form) and do not provide tax advice—employees with tax questions are referred to their tax advisor or the IRS toll-free information line, 1-800-TAX-1040 (1-800-829-1040). Employees with questions on FSAs are referred to the Travelers hotline described below.

Travelers Toll-Free Hotline

Beginning June 1, 1992, Travelers will provide a toll-free hotline for FSA inquiries. Employees with general FSA questions may use the hotline by calling 1-800-842-2026. Following enrollment, participants may use the hotline to make account inquiries.—*Employee Relations Dept., 5-28-92*

Public Housing Agency Notices— Apartment Resident Evictions

The National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 provides that public housing agencies (PHAs) must notify the local post office if an individual or family is evicted for criminal activity, including drug related criminal activity. To implement this provision, the Department of Housing and Urban Development recently adopted rules stating that the PHA *must* notify the post office serving the dwelling unit that the evicted individual or family no longer resides in this unit.

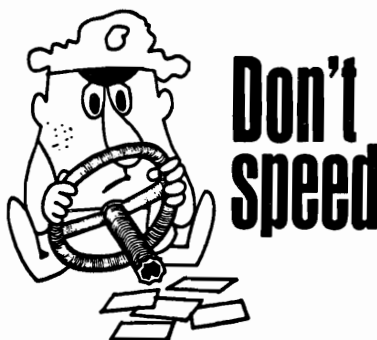
The purpose of this post office notification provision stated in the regulation follows:

So that the post office will terminate the delivery of mail for such (evicted) persons at the unit, and that such persons not return to the project for pickup of the mail.

Personnel should handle mail for these evicted tenants in accordance with the general procedures for treatment of mail which is undeliverable-as-addressed. Under these procedures, mail is undeliverable-as-addressed when there is clear evidence that the addressee is no longer at the designated address. While it is preferable that the addressee provide change-of-address information, personnel should honor a written notice from the PHA, on the PHA's letterhead if available, and treat the mail in question as undeliverable-as-addressed.

Personnel should handle this undeliverable mail in accordance with the Domestic Mail Manual (DMM), section 159.326 (b), which authorizes a 10-day holding period when the addressee moves without leaving a forwarding order. If no forwarding order is received within this time period, the carrier *must* initiate Form 3575, *Change of Address Order* for "moved left no address," after the mail is sent to a Computerized Forwarding System (CFS) unit for processing.

Federal Employees Group Life Insurance

The most recent issue of Standard Form 2821, *Agency Certification of Insurance Status* (July 1991), contains a new Item 4b, which is used to indicate retirement coverage. The Office of Personnel Management (OPM) has indicated that personnel offices must use this edition of the form.

Personnel may requisition the new SF 2821 from the materiel distribution centers (MDCs) on Form 7380, *MDC Supply Requisition*. All previous editions of the form are obsolete.

As a reminder, individuals responsible for completing SF 2821 must ensure that Item 7 of the form reflects the date SF 2819, *Notice of Conversion Privilege*, was issued. An employee must receive SF 2819 when Federal Employees Group Life Insurance (FEGLI) terminates under conditions entitling the employee to convert to an individual policy. All retiring employees must also receive SF 2819, regardless of their eligibility to continue FEGLI coverage into retirement. The notice informs employees that if they are eligible and wish to carry FEGLI coverage into retirement, they should not apply for conversion. Section 2, Retirement of Employee, of the Instructions to Employing Agencies, printed on the back of the SF 2821, describes occasions when a retiring employee may want to consider a conversion policy.

Reminder

Verification of Mailing Statements

All current mailing statements contain a box to designate the Processing Category. A recent review of completed mailing statements shows that mailers frequently leave this box blank or complete it incorrectly. Domestic Mail Manual 128 includes information about the requirements for the various processing categories.

Processing category information is vital for data collection. Supervisors should remind acceptance employees that they must ensure that the mailing statement (including the processing category) is completed correctly. They should also bring this requirement to the attention of mailers who habitually provide incorrect or no information. In addition, employees who enter mailing statement data into the PERMIT and BRAVIS systems should record the processing category data correctly.

DMM Notice

OVERSEAS MILITARY MAIL—STANDARDIZED ADDRESSES

Effective with *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) Issue 43 (6-21-92), DMM 122.81 is revised to reflect the standardized addressing of overseas military mail implemented by the Postal Service on July 15, 1991. The new standardized addresses must be used effective July 15, 1992.

Address standardization changes the last two lines of military addresses to conform to addressing practices for other U.S. Mail. Military APO/FPO ZIP Codes now have three new state abbreviations: AA, AE, and AP, which replace the previous designations of New York, Miami, San Francisco, and Seattle.

122.8 Military Mail**122.81 Overseas Military Mail**

(Delete existing 122.815; then renumber existing 122.811 through 122.814 as 122.812 through 122.815; add new 122.811 as follows:)

122.811 Elements of Standardized Delivery Addresses. Overseas military addresses must conform to domestic addressing standards. The delivery line must reflect ship's name, UNIT number, or PSC number, and BOX number if assigned. The last line must contain the APO or FPO designation, the appropriate two-letter "state" abbreviation of AA, AE, or AP, followed by the ZIP + 4 or five-digit ZIP Code. The state abbreviations replace previous designations of Miami, New York, and San Francisco and Seattle, respectively. AA is used with the three-digit ZIP Code prefix 340, AE with ZIPs 090-098, and AP with ZIPs 962-966.

122.812 Army. Mail addressed to Army personnel must indicate grade; full name, including first name and middle name or initial; UNIT number; APO; state abbreviation; and ZIP + 4 or five-digit ZIP Code.

122.813 Air Force. Mail addressed to Air Force personnel must indicate grade; full name, including first name and middle name or initial; PSC or UNIT number; APO; state abbreviation; and ZIP + 4 or five-digit ZIP Code.

266.1 Contract Obligations. These are claims resulting from damage to leased vehicles while in postal custody and are adjudicated and paid as contractual obligations rather than tort claims. Payment may not exceed the contractor's loss. When a postal employee causes a vehicle to be damaged, an eligible contractor may claim, and is entitled to receive, the actual cost of returning the vehicle to its condition before the damage occurred, or replacement of it with a vehicle of like age and condition, whichever amount is less. Verify that the postal employee reports all damage inflicted on the contractor's vehicle so that all valid claims may be paid.

267.5 Investigation by Manager Vehicle Programs/Services. On the basis of information on Form 5201 and SF 91, the fleet manager will:

- Investigate to determine whether damage was a result of an act or negligence of a postal employee, mail contractor, or contractor's employee, or the result of an act by a third party.
- Inspect the vehicle to verify the reported damages.
- Estimate probable repair cost.
- Retain all documentation pertaining to the damage, pending receipt of the claim.

A future edition of Handbook PO-701 will include these revisions.

Effective with *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) Issue 43 (6-21-92), DMM 126.22 is revised to reflect the current address format for items authorized for transmission by the U.S. Department of State. In addition, DMM 126.23 is revised to include certified mail among special services not available for transmission through Department of State facilities.

Express Mail, registered, certified, insured, COD, special delivery, special handling, and return receipt for merchandise are not available for mail transmitted through Department of State facilities. When addressed for transmission via the Department of State, mail sent by any special service above is returned to the sender endorsed Service Not Available.

DMM Notice

Prohibited Closures for Automation Compatibility

Effective with *Domestic Mail Manual* (DMM) Issue 43 (6-21-92), DMM 521.42 is changed to clarify the types of exterior closures prohibited on mail submitted for automation-based rates (ZIP + 4 or ZIP + 4 barcoded).

Certain closures cannot be processed through the Postal Service's automated sortation equipment. Closures that are inflexible or protrude such as buttons, clasps, or staples, can jam or damage the equipment or damage other mail during processing.

Previous requirements had already established a prohibition on any protrusion that might impede or damage mail processing equipment. This change more clearly specifies the prohibited closure materials and the other types of materials that may be prohibited depending on their potential for hindering mail processing. This change also establishes the acceptability of staples affixed to booklet-type mailpieces submitted for automation-based rates when properly placed and securely fastened.

* * * * *

521.42 Prohibited Closures

521.421 Clasps, String, Buttons. Clasps, string, buttons, or like materials must not be used to close mailpieces claimed at any of the automation-based rates (ZIP + 4 or ZIP + 4 barcoded). Other protrusions that may impede or damage the mail or mail processing equipment are also prohibited. Exterior staples are prohibited except for booklet-type mailpieces.

521.422 Staples. Staples must not be used as a tabbing or wafer seal substitute for automation-based rates. For automation-compatibility, staples or saddle stitching may be used only on booklet-type mailpieces to join the bound edge or spine. When used this way, the staple must be parallel with the bound edge or spine and must seal tightly and securely so it does not protrude and impede or damage the mail or mail processing equipment.

Postal Convenience Center Panel: Installation

When installing Notice 100-ABC, Postal Convenience Center Panels, in the lobby scale well area (area surrounding the weighing and rating units), add the following to step 4:

Add one teaspoon of either glass cleaner or dish soap to one quart of water. Lightly spray the backing material of the panel.

This procedure allows the panel to be centered and squared in a much faster and easier manner.

Effective immediately, Exhibit 241.51, Countries Which Prohibit Printed Matter Enclosures, is revised to reflect a new list of countries. Printed matter articles sent to the countries listed in Exhibit 241.51 may contain as enclosures, a card, envelope, or wrapper bearing *only the printed address of the sender or the sender's agent in the United States.*

Printed matter articles sent to the countries not listed in Exhibit 241.51 may contain as enclosures, a card, envelope, or wrapper bearing the printed address of the sender or the sender's agent *either in the United States or in the country of destination of the original mailpiece.*

Third-Class Enclosures at Special Fourth-Class Rates

This article clarifies the rules for third-class matter enclosed with special fourth-class mail.

Domestic Mail Manual (DMM) 724.32 provides that any printed matter which would be mailable as third-class mail may be included loose with any qualifying material mailed at the special fourth-class rates of postage. Postage on third-class printed matter is charged at special fourth-class rates.

In accordance with *DMM 136.322*, the third-class rate must be paid for the mailing of any third-class item other than printed matter (or an item subject to the third-class rates which is not specifically provided for in *DMM 721.2* or *724.3* as a permissible enclosure) that is enclosed in a parcel containing special fourth-class rate material for which the special fourth-class rate of postage is being paid.

Postal Quarter III Philatelic Products Report

The Postal Quarter (PQ) III, Fiscal Year (FY) 1992 philatelic inventory survey begins on Monday, June 1, 1992. It is imperative that all associate offices and management sectional centers (MSCs) complete, verify, and forward their reports according to schedule because the final PQ III survey report will not include late figures.

Associate offices must submit all PQ III survey reports on Form 1079, *Philatelic Product Physical Inventory Recap*. The reverse side of the form has directions for preparing it. Previous forms are obsolete.

By June 5, 1992, all associate offices must forward the completed *Philatelic Product Physical Inventory Recap*, printed in this Bulletin, to their MSC office. MSCs will use these forms to prepare a consolidated report using Form 1079-C, *Philatelic Product Inventory and Sales Report*, which the New York Postal Data Center (PDC) will send them the week of May 18. Any MSC that does not receive its Form 1079-C by May 28 should contact the PDC supervisor at (212) 613-8560 or PEN 212-664-8560.

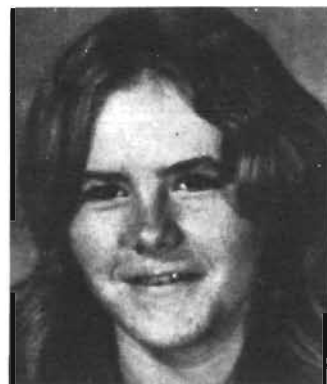

Companion posters, authorized for display on bulletin boards maintained by employee organizations, appear periodically in *The Postal Record*, a publication for members of the National Association of Letter Carriers.

This poster is published in cooperation with the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, the United States Department of Justice, and the National Association of Letter Carriers. Information appearing on this poster is selected solely by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. For policy and information on Postal Service support in efforts to recover missing children, see POSTAL BULLETIN 21536, page 1, October 17, 1985.

Missing Children Posters are available from the U.S. Postal Service *only* through periodic issues of the POSTAL BULLETIN.

PROCEDURES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING FORM 1079

I. COPY DISTRIBUTION AND TIMING

AOs—Submit completed form to MSC one week after close of Quarter.

MSCs—Three weeks after close of Quarter submit consolidated report.

Where special regional instructions direct the MSC consolidated report to the Region for review prior to sending to PDC, these instructions should be followed.

II. SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS—FORM 1079

1. With reference to LINE 16, please include only those items whose numbers are listed. Any inventory and sales information for other collecting kits should be included on LINE 22.
2. For LINE 22, also enter the *dollar amount sold* (Column I) in Column D and Column G *only*, as if each inventory item cost \$1. Round off figures to the nearest whole dollar. (Entries *must* be made in *both* indicated columns to trigger computer operation.) It is *not necessary* to make any entries in Columns C, E, or F on LINE 28.
3. Use only the issue of Form 1079 specified in the most recent POSTAL BULLETIN notice or other instructions for the PQ survey. Using earlier issues will adversely impact PDC key punching and other operations.

III. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS—FORM 1079

1. COLUMN (A) LINE REFERENCE

Self-explanatory.

2. **COLUMN (B):** Please refer to separate instructions listing the revisions and write-in entries, if any, needed in this column for the current survey.

3. COLUMN (C) ON HAND BEGINNING OF QUARTER

AO—Refer to previous quarter's report for "On Hand at End of Quarter"—Column F. Column C of this report must be the same as Column F of the previous quarter's report.

MSC—On consolidated report Column C must equal "On Hand at End of Quarter" of the previous quarter's report. Note this data comes preprinted on computerized Form 1079-C and should not be modified. Refer to separate instructions for details.

4. COLUMN (D) INCREASE/RECEIPTS AND ADJUSTMENTS

AO—Record totals by product received from MSC/SDO during the quarter.

MSC—Include only totals to those philatelic products received by the MSC/SDO from outside the MSC such as new products sent by contractor, transfers from Regional APD or from another MSC, during the quarter. **DO NOT** include shipments received from your AOs or stations and branches as returned stock.

5. COLUMN (E) DECREASE/SHIPMENTS AND ADJUSTMENTS

AO—Record totals by product shipped back to the MSC/SDO by the AO during the quarter. If any stock was returned for destruction at MSC/SDO, attach letter stating amount by products to your 1079 when returned to MSC.

MSC—Include only totals to those philatelic products shipped out of the MSC such as shipments to the Regional ADP or to other MSC/SDO. *Do not* include shipments to your AOs or stations and branches. Also any products that have been destroyed by Form 3238, *Destruction Certificate*, or items authorized for promotional use as displays are to be included in this column.

6. COLUMN (F) ON HAND AT END OF QUARTER

AO—Record actual item count of AOs' Main Stock and individual clerk stock. If clerk is on leave or otherwise unavailable at report time, count stock prior to departure, if possible.

MSC—Consolidate all AO, station and branch reports and include MSC/SDO Main Stock and Main Office individual clerk stock.

7. COLUMN (G) TOTAL SOLD

AO—Determine total of each product sold during quarter using following formula:

Columns (C, D, E, F) total items sold.

MSC—Consolidate MSC, station and branch plus AO reports and use same formula as above to determine MSC total sold of each item.

8. COLUMN (H) UNIT SELLING PRICE

Self-explanatory.

9. COLUMN (I) TOTAL COLUMN

Please note it is *not required* for either the AO or the MSC to complete this column (Col G x Col H), since the computer program at the PDC automatically calculates the sales revenue dollars and enters them in the "TOTAL" column. Some AOs and MSC may want to manually calculate total sales dollars for the quarter for their own records and use. Where that is the case, they may optionally fill in the total column.

IV. A REMINDER ON FORMS DISTRIBUTION

Space Commemorative Stamps

A broad spectrum of space exploration—past, present, and future—is displayed on the dramatic Space block of four commemorative stamps issued May 29, a joint issue with Russia, at the WORLD COLUMBIAN STAMP EXPO '92 in suburban Chicago, Illinois. The set-tenant composite design for the 29-cent U.S. and the 25-ruble Russian blocks of four was developed in a joint collaboration by Robert T. McCall of Paradise Valley, Arizona, and Vladimir Beilin of Moscow, Russia. The Space design features most of the significant achievements in space exploration in the last 35 years and gives equal emphasis to the achievements of each country.

How to Obtain the U.S. First Day of Issue Postmark

The first day of issue postmark will be available for 90 days. After adjust-

ments for currency exchange rates, the Russian stamps will cost 47 cents each, \$1.88 for the block of four, and \$15.04 for the complete pane of 32.

How to Obtain the Russian First Day of Issue Postmark

Customers have 90 days to obtain the first day of issue postmark by mail. After purchasing the stamps, customers may affix the stamps to envelopes of choice, and place the envelopes in a larger envelope addressed to: CUSTOMER AFFIXED ENVELOPES,* RUSSIAN SPACE STAMPS, POSTMASTER, DES PLAINES IL 60018-9993.

The Postal Service will affix either a single (selected at random; no requests of particular stamps will be honored) or a block of four Russian stamps, up to a maximum of 50 envelopes. Customers should send envelopes and 47 cents per single stamp or \$1.88 per block of four, in check or money order, to: RUSSIAN SPACE STAMPS,* POSTMASTER, 1000 E OAKTON ST, DES PLAINES IL 60018-9994.

*Orders for Russian stamps must include a self-addressed envelope with sufficient U.S. First-Class postage for the return of the envelopes through the mail.

How to Obtain U.S.-Russian Combination First Day of Issue Postmarks

Customers may prepare combination covers with the U.S. and Russian stamps affixed on one envelope. Each country's first day of issue will only be applied to its respective stamps. Therefore, customers submitting combination covers are advised to leave sufficient space on the envelopes for both cancellations. Envelopes that do not allow cancellations to be applied without touching the stamps of the other country will be returned unsorted. Kentucky Statehood Commemorative Stamp

The stamp, designed by Joseph Petro of Lexington, Kentucky, features My Old Kentucky Home State Park in Bardstown. The home was immortalized in the Stephen Collins Foster song, which became Kentucky's official state song in 1928.

Hummingbirds Commemorative Stamps

The Postal Service issues five 29-cent Hummingbirds commemorative stamps on June 15 during the National Audubon Society's convention at American University in Washington, DC, in booklets of 20. The stamps, designed by noted wildlife artist and veteran stamp designer Chuck Ripper, feature the broad-billed, calliope, costa's, ruby-throated, and rufous hummingbirds.

Hummingbirds, often called the helicopters of the avian world, have evolved a unique form of flight. While other birds can hover for a moment or two, the darting, start-stop, up-down, forward-backward flight of hummers belongs to them alone. Hummingbirds scull the air rather than stroke it, gaining constant lift from what is more of a forward-and-backward movement than the more usual up-and-down flapping of other birds. When hovering, their bodies assume a nearly vertical position. To power such an extraordinary set of wings, which never have a rest when the bird is in flight, hummingbirds have the largest pectoral muscles for their size of any animal alive.

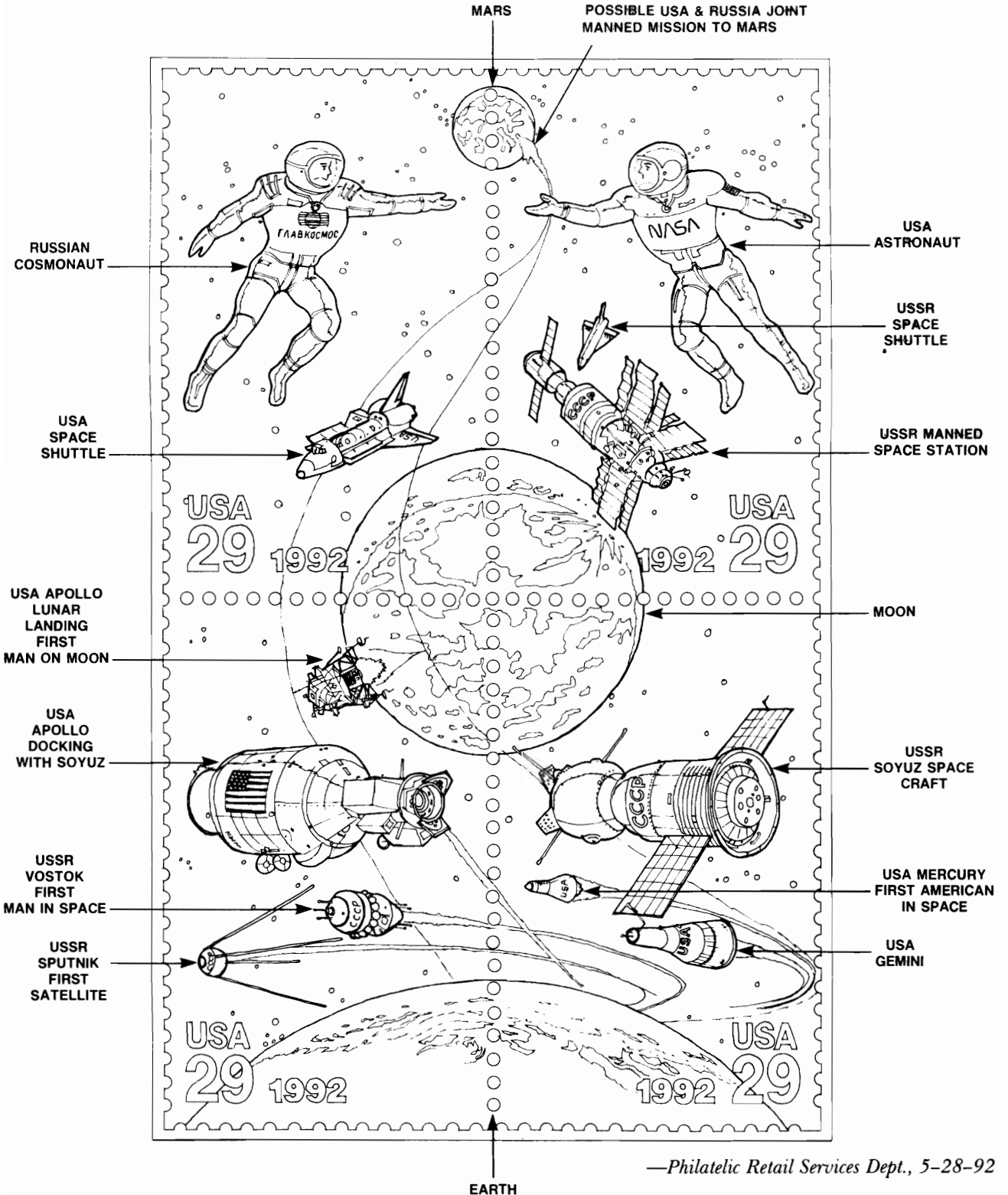

29-CENT SPACE COMMEMORATIVE STAMPS

The block of four 29-cent Space commemorative stamps goes on sale May 29 in Des Plaines, Illinois. The block of stamps is a joint issue with Russia (formerly of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics).

The four *setenant* designs are based on a painting prepared jointly by a U.S. designer and a Russian designer. The stamps depict space accomplishments by both countries and project the possibility of joint space ventures in the future.

The diagram provides an explanation of the space accomplishments shown in the designs. Personnel should widely disseminate it for use in answering customer inquiries.



Conditions Applied to Mail Addressed to Military Post Offices Overseas

Mail addressed to, from, or between military post offices overseas is subject to certain conditions or restrictions of mailing regarding content, preparation, and handling. The table below outlines these conditions by APO/FPO (army post office/fleet post office) ZIP Code through the use of footnoted mailing restriction codes, which appear on the last page of the table.

Whenever mail is presented to them, acceptance clerks must use this table in conjunction with the integrated retail terminal (IRT) to verify whether the APO/FPO ZIP Code is active and what conditions of mailing apply. For Express Mail Military Service (EMMS) availability, refer to Handbook PO-514, *Express Mail Military Service*, and the local EMMS directory.

The entire table appears in the second regularly scheduled Postal Bulletin of each month. Changes occurring between issues, as well as those that take effect with the monthly issuance, are highlighted in bold print.

- A. Securities, currency, or precious metals in their raw, unmanufactured state are prohibited. Official shipments are exempt from this restriction.
- B. Form 2966-A is required. Prepaid mail from a contractor addressed to a military organization for official use need not bear a customs declaration, but must be endorsed "Contents For Official Use--Exempt from Customs Requirement." Official mail from government agencies does not require a customs declaration or an exemption endorsement.
 - B1. Form 2966-B is required. Articles are liable for customs duty and/or purchase tax unless they are bona fide gifts intended for use by military personnel or their dependents. When the contents of a parcel meet these requirements, the mailer must endorse the customs form, "Certified to be a bona fide gift, personal effects, or items for personal use of military personnel and dependents," under the heading, Description of Contents.
 - B2. Form 2966-A is required except on official mail, which does not require customs declaration or exemption endorsement. The AAFES will furnish a computer listing of all items mailed from its activities to Philippine APOs. Other mail order companies must either use Form 2966-A on each item or provide computer lists. Computer listings must include a description of the items, the dollar value of the items, a complete address including the PSC box number and APO of the addressee, the date of mailing, the insurance or registry number, if applicable, and the serial number of any item over \$25 in value and any electrical item with a plug over \$15 in value.
 - B3. Form 2966-A is required for mailing between MPOs. Prepaid mail from contractors addressed to a military organization for official use need not bear customs declaration, but must be endorsed, "Contents for Official Use--Exempt from Customs Requirement." Official mail from government agencies does not require customs declaration or exemption endorsement.
- C. Cigarettes and other tobacco products are prohibited.
- D. Coffee is prohibited.
 - E1. Medicines or vaccines not conforming to French laws are prohibited.
 - E2. Any matter containing religious materials contrary to Islamic faith or depicting nude or seminude persons, pornographic or sexual items, or nonauthorized political materials are prohibited.
 - E3. Radio transceivers or cordless telephones are prohibited.
- F. Firearms of any type are prohibited in all classes of mail. See definition of firearms in DMM 124.5. This restriction does not apply to firearms mailed to or by official U.S. government agencies.
 - F1. Privately owned weapons addressed to an individual are

- prohibited in any class of mail.
 - F2. Importation of firearms is restricted to one shotgun and one single shot .22 caliber rifle per individual.
 - G. Only First-Class letters, second- and third-class mail is authorized.
 - H. Meats, including preserved meats, whether hermetically sealed or not, are prohibited.
 - H1. Pork and/or pork by-products are prohibited.
 - I. Mail of all classes may not exceed the following dimensions:

 - I1. This restriction does not apply to registered mail.
 - I2. This restriction does not apply to official government mail marked MOM.
 - K. Mail which includes in the address the words, "Dependent Mail Section," may consist only of letter mail, newspapers, magazines and books. No parcel of any class containing any other matter may be mailed to the Dependent Mail Section. This restriction does not apply if the address does not include the words "Dependent Mail Section."
 - L. All official mail is prohibited.
 - M. Fruits, animals, and living plants are prohibited.
 - N. Registered mail is prohibited.
 - O. Personal mail addressed to vessels using this number is limited to unregistered First-Class Mail and certified mail. Other classes of mail are prohibited.
 - P. APO is used for the receipt and dispatch of official mail only.
 - Q. Mail may not exceed 66 pounds, and size is limited to 42 inches maximum length and 72 inches maximum length and girth combined.
 - R. All alcoholic beverages, including those mailable under DMM part 124.42 are prohibited.
 - T. Mailings of case lots of food and supplemental household shipments must be approved by the sender's parent agency prior to mailing.
 - U. Parcels must weigh less than 16 ounces when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped."
 - U1. Mail is limited to First-Class Mail weighing 12 ounces or less when addressed to Box R. This restriction does not apply to mail endorsed "Free Matter for the Blind or Handicapped." Video tapes are prohibited when addressed to Box R regardless of weight.
 - U2. Mail is limited to First-Class letters only when addressed to Box R.
 - U3. Mail is limited to First-Class correspondence (including voice and video cassettes), newspapers, magazines, photographs, not exceeding 16 ounces, when addressed to Box R.
 - W. Meat products, such as dried beef, salami, and sausage may be mailed, provided they remain in their original, hermetically sealed packages and bear USDA certification. Other meats, bones, skin, hair, feathers, horns or hoofs of hoofed animals, wool samples, tobacco leaves, including chewing and pipe tobacco, snuff, cigars, and cigarettes, or obscene material, including obscene drawings, photographs, films, and carvings are prohibited. Exception: 200 grams of tobacco per parcel are permitted duty free.
 - X. Personal mail is limited to First-Class Mail (to include audio cassettes and voice tapes) weighing 11 ounces or less. This limitation does not apply to official mail.
 - Y. Mail is limited to First-Class and Priority Mail only. All second-class, third-class, and fourth-class mail (including SAM and PAL) are not authorized. This restriction also applies to official mail.

Travel/Relocation Vouchers: High Cost Localities

Travel Vouchers. All personnel submitting, reviewing, and approving travel/relocation vouchers should familiarize themselves with existing policy on the above procedures. They must submit travel/relocation vouchers on a timely basis. Handbooks F-10, *Travel Policy*, sections 132 f and 741; F-12, *Relocation Policy*, section 170 f.; and F-11, *PCES Relocation Policy*, sections 251, 350, and 440 governs the frequency for submitting vouchers.

To circumvent delays in processing vouchers:

- Claim expenses within policy and support them with acceptable documentation.
- Check the math.
- Have original signatures of the payee and approving official.
- Include Social Security number, current address, finance numbers, account numbers, etc.

Uniform Program Inquiries

The following clarifications respond to field inquiries with respect to certain provisions of the uniform and work clothes program regarding uniform invoice dates and employee anniversary dates.

- The actual uniform purchase invoice date should reflect the date the items were shipped. Or, when employees buy directly from a local store, the date they receive the goods.
- Employees have 1 full year from their designated anniversary year (as stated on their current *Employee Uniform Allowance Statement*) to make a uniform or work clothes purchase for that anniversary year. For instance, if an employee's anniversary date is 3-17-92, he/she may make a purchase for that allowance year between March 17, 1992 and March 16, 1993. Otherwise, the Postal Service will not honor the invoices.

IMM, Publication 51, Revisions

International Mail—Latvia

Effective immediately, the individual country sheet for Latvia is amended to reflect a new list of prohibitions and a new 44-pound weight limit (air and surface) for parcel post. Previously, the parcel post weight limit was 22 pounds. Postal personnel should (1) insert the new list in the prohibitions section in the country sheet for Latvia, and (2) delete the 22-pound parcel post rate table and insert the following 44-pound rate table.

Prohibitions

The following items are prohibited:

- Any kind of weapons, their components, ammunition, explosives, and other similar articles, as well as special chemical products and devices for their use;
- Narcotics and psychotropic substances and devices for their use;
- Pornographic material or items;
- Raw materials of animal origin;
- Products produced from flora; hyacinth bulbs, carnation and chrysanthemum seedling and cuttings, seeds of leguminous plants, seeds of quarantine plants.

Restrictions

Animal products (except canned foods) must be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary service. No certificate is required for canned food. Products of flora must be accompanied by a plant health certificate (fitosanitary certificate.)

The next issue of the *International Mail Manual* and Publication 51, *International Postal Rates and Fees*, will incorporate these changes. Integrated retail terminal (IRT) software is being modified to reflect them. In the interim, window clerks should refer to the above parcel post rate chart.

In columns 34-38, include five zeros (00000) for the destination ZIP Code for empty sack and pouch labels. Choose the appropriate three-digit CIN from the list below and enter it in columns 39-41.
