The British Protectorates of Zanzibar and East Africa Members of the Universal Postal Union.

> POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT, OFFICE OF FOREIGN MAILS, WASHINGTON, D. C., Jan. 9, 1896.

The adhesion, on the 1st of December, 1895, of the British Protectorates of Zanzibar and East Africa, to the Universal Postal Union Convention and the Regulations for its execution signed in Vienna, on the 4th of July, 1891, has been announced through the proper diplomatic channel. R. P. O.

The entrance of the Protetorates of Zanzibar and East Africa to the Postal Union makes no change in the postage rates and conditions now applicable to articles mailed in the United States addressed for delivery in those Protectorates, the Postal Union regimen having been extended to said correspondence by the Postmaster General's order dated November 30, 1894.
