### BOOKS OF POSTAGE STAMPS FOR SALE

POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT,

OFFICE OF THIRD ASSISTANT POSTMASTER GENERAL,

WASHINGTON, D. C., February 26, 1900.

About May 1, 1900, the Post Office Department will be ready to supply postmasters, for sale to the public, small books of 2-cent stamps, inter-leaved with paraffined paper to prevent premature adhesion. The pages are of six stamps each, making a book of convenient size to carry in the pocket or pocketbook.

Only three different quantities will be so furnished: One book of twelve 2-cent stamps; one book of twenty-four 2-cent stamps, and one book of forty-eight 2-cent stamps; of postage value, 24, 48 and 96 cents, respectively. Each book will be sold at an advance of one cent on the stamp value, to cover the cost of binding (See table below).

Postmasters at all offices may secure these books of stamps for sale by ordering them on form No. 5203, which blank will be furnished by the Division of Supplies for the Post Office Department, Office of the First Assistant Postmaster General, on and after April 15.

Not less than ten of any one kind of these books will be supplied to a postmaster, and the prices at which they are to be charged to him and sold to the public are as follows:

Postmasters will be required to keep a separate and exact account of these books, to enable them to render a report, at the end of the quarter, of the number and value of those sold.
