In the payment of salaries to all post office employees, postmasters are required to have the pay-rolls or vouchers properly filled out before allowing employees to sign. The exact amount for which each employee receipts must be plainly written in ink before the rolls are signed. This applies to semi-monthly and monthly rolls as well as to the quarterly pay-rolls submitted to the Auditor as vouchers.
