### ORDER OF THE POSTMASTER GENERAL.

OFFICE OF THE POSTMASTER GENERAL,  
WASHINGTON, D. C., June 2, 1904.

ORDER NO. 551.

1. All mail matter originating in the United States for transmission to any of the "Possessions of the United States" named in paragraph 3 of this order shall be subject to the United States domestic classification, conditions and rates of postage.

2. All mail matter originating in the "Possessions of the United States" named in paragraph 3 of this order, for transmission to the United States, or from one to another of those possessions, shall be subject to the United States domestic classification, conditions and rates of postage.

3. In this order, Hawaii and Porto Rico are included in the term "United States;" and the Philippine Archipelago, Guam, Tutuila (including all adjacent islands of the Samoan Group which are possessions of the United States), and the Canal Zone are included in the term "Possessions of the United States." The term "Canal Zone" includes all the territory purchased of Panama, comprising the "Canal Zone" proper and the islands in the Bay of Panama named Perico, Naos, Culebra and Flamenco.

4. United States postage stamps, postal cards and stamped envelopes shall be valid for the payment of postage on mail matter originating in the "Possessions of the United States," except as provided in the following notes:

**NOTE 1.** In the Philippine Archipelago such stamped paper shall not be accepted in payment of postage unless overprinted "Philippines," except in case of the reply half of a one-cent double postal card, which shall be valid for postage without being overprinted when mailed in the Philippines to the United States or any of its possessions.

**NOTE 2.** Stamped paper overprinted "Philippines" is not valid for postage elsewhere than in the Philippine Archipelago, except in case of the reply half of a one-cent double postal card overprinted "Philippines," which is valid when mailed in the United States, or any of its possessions, to the Philippines.

5. All mail matter, whatever its class, addressed to persons in the United States service (civil, military or naval), serving in the United States or any of its possessions, or en route to or from the United States or any of its possessions, whose change of address is caused by official orders, shall be transmitted as rapidly as possible until it reaches the addressee; the actual location of the addressee for the time being shall be considered as the original destination of the piece of mail matter; such transmission shall not be considered as "forwarding" in the sense in which that word is used in the postal service, and no additional postage shall be required therefor.

**NOTE.**—To insure prompt delivery, mail matter sent to persons in the United States service should include in the address the complete designation of the organization, company and regiment, vessel or other branch of the service to which the addressee belongs; and the postage thereon should be fully prepaid.

6. Letters sent by soldiers, sailors and marines in the United States service, located in the United States or any of its possessions, addressed to places in the United States or any of its possessions, when endorsed "Soldier's letter," "Sailor's letter" or "Marine's letter," as the case may be, and signed thereunder either with facsimile hand stamp or in writing, with his official designation, by a field or staff officer, post or detachment commander,

to whose command the soldier belongs, or by a surgeon or chaplain at a hospital where he may be; and in the navy and marine service by any commissioned officer attached to the vessel, or officer commanding a hospital or detachment ashore, may be dispatched to destination without prepayment of postage, and only the single rate of postage shall be collected on delivery.

7. Any article entitled to transmission free of postage in the domestic mails of the United States, either in a "penalty" envelope or under a duly authorized "frank," shall be entitled likewise to transmission in the mails free of postage between places in any possession of the United States, from one to another of such possessions, from the United States to such possessions, and from such possessions to the United States.

8. The registration fee shall be eight cents, in addition to the lawful postage.

9. This order supersedes Order No. 1283, November 18, 1902, which is hereby revoked; and all existing orders conflicting herewith are modified accordingly.
