The Postmaster General has issued the following orders:

Designating Westend Station of the post office at Pine Bluff, Ark., as independent for the receipt and dispatch of registered mails, from Feb. 15, 1906.

Establishing Station No 266 of the post office at Chicago, Ill., at Cottage Grove Avenue and 43d Street, with facilities for the transaction of money-order and registry business and the sale of postal supplies.

Establishing on Feb. 15, 1906, Station A of the post office at Waterloo, Iowa, at 620 Sycamore Street, with facilities for the transaction of money-order and registry business, the sale of postal supplies, and the receipt and dispatch of mails.

**Philippines—Dispatch of Mails For.**

February 9, 1906.

GENERAL ORDER No. 622.  
Mails for the Philippines being domestic mails do not come within the provisions of section 1519, Postal Laws and Regulations, in regard to the treatment of specially addressed matter for foreign countries. Requests for special routing of this mail should therefore be ignored, and it should take the regular channel.
