#### ORDER OF THE POSTMASTER GENERAL.

OFFICE OF THE POSTMASTER GENERAL,  
WASHINGTON, D. C., Dec. 14, 1908.

ORDER No. 1942.

Pursuant to a special agreement between this Department and the Postal Administration of Germany, it is HEREBY ORDERED, that, commencing on January 1, 1909, the postage rate applicable to letters mailed in the United States for Germany and dispatched by sea direct and not via England or France shall be two cents an ounce or fraction of an ounce. When such letters are unpaid or short-paid the deficient postage shall be collected on delivery at double the above rate.

Letters for Germany shall not be dispatched via England or France at the above rate even though specially addressed to be so dispatched. (Sec. 693, par. 15, P. L. & R., for forwarding specially-addressed letters is hereby amended accordingly.)

This ORDER applies only to letters mailed in the States and Territories of the United States, including Alaska, on the mainland of North America, and does not extend to letters mailed in Hawaii, Porto Rico, The Philippines, or other possessions of the United States.

#### Discontinuance of the Post Office Registry Transfer Station at Kansas City, Mo.

Because of the establishment of a Terminal R. P. O. at Kansas City, Mo., effective Dec. 15, 1908, the separate registry transfer station heretofore attached to the Kansas City, Mo., post office will be discontinued. Postmasters are therefore instructed to cancel the words "Kansas City, Mo.," in the list in paragraph 60 on page 66 of the July, 1908, Postal Guide, showing the names of post offices having separate stations for handling transit registered mail.
