The United States of Colombia a Member of the Postal Union July 1, 1881.

POST OFFICE DEPARTMENT, OFFICE OF FOREIGN MAILS, WASHINGTON, D. C., June 21, 1881.

On and after July 1st next, the United States of Colombia, which has declared its adhesion to the Paris Convention of the Universal Postal Union, will be embraced in said Union, and correspondence from the United States of America addressed thereto will be subject to the postal charges and treatment applicable to correspondence exchanged by mail with other Postal Union countries.

Mails for the United States of Colombia are made up at and dispatched from the offices of New York, N.Y., and San Francisco, Cal. Correspondence for that country posted at other United States post offices should be forwarded either to New York or San Francisco, as may be most expeditious.
