To All Postmusters:

This office has received notice of the adhesion to the Universal Postal Union, October 1, 1911, of the British Protectorates of the Gilbert and Ellice Islands and of the Solomon Islands.

Postmasters are therefore informed that all mailable matter addressed for delivery in the Gilbert and Ellice Islands and the Solomon Islands may now be accepted for registration. That portion of the instructions appearing in Article 234, page 123, of the July, 1911, Postal Guide that refers to the Ellice and Gilbert Islands is modified accordingly.
