RAILROAD SERVICE CHANGES.

IOWA.

Route 27086. Oskaloosa to Brighton. From January 13, 1883, embrace Ioka, bet. Nugent Station (n. o.) and Richland.

NEW JERSEY.

Route 7008. Trenton to Manunka Chunk. From December 31, 1882, omit Trenton.

TEXAS.

Route 31027. Galveston to Lampassas. From January 1, 1883, embrace Gay Hill, bet. Brenham and Krohne.

STAR SERVICE CHANGES.

DELAWARE.

Route 9555. Kirkwood to Delaware City. From January 8, 1883, curtail route to end at Saint George, omitting Delaware City, decrease distance 4 ms.

ILLINOIS.

Route 23115. Des Plaines to Des Plaines. From January 1, 1883, omit East Northfield and make route for Des Plaines, by Wheeling, North Northfield, West Northfield and The Grove, to Des Plaines, decrease distance $4\frac{1}{2}$ ms.

IOWA.

Route 27430. Denison to Harlan. From January 1, 1883, curtail service to end at Defiance, decrease distance 18 ms.

KANSAS.

Route 33419. Great Bend to Dorrance. Omit Great Bend and Buena Vista during prevalence of small-pox.

KENTUCKY.

Route 20107. Florence to Erlanger. Begin instead of end at Erlanger.

MICHIGAN.

Route 24537. Palmer to Negaunee. From January 1, to June 30, 1883, service 5 ms. and back, 6 times a week.

NEBRASKA.

Route 34156. York to Central City. From January 1, 1883, embrace Bradshaw, omit York and Central City. Begin at Arborville, end at Bradshaw, decrease distance 26 ms. Increase service to 6 times a week.

Route 34264. Ford to Little. From January 1, 1883, restate route as follows: From Ford, by Cache Creek and Ferndale, to Little, $23\frac{1}{2}$ ms.

NORTH CAROLINA.

Route 13570. Elizabeth City to Manteo. From January 1, to June 30, 1883, service 45 ms and back, 2 times a week, in a safe and suitable sail boat.
