Parcel-Post Packages for Australia, Santa Cruz Islands, and Friendly (Tonga) Islands, Not Acceptable for Registration.

THIRD ASST. POSTMASTER GENERAL,
Washington, January 11, 1921.

Postmasters are advised that parcel-post packages for Australia, Santa Cruz Islands, and Friendly (Tonga) Islands, can not be accepted for registration. Mailable parcel-post packages for New Zealand may be accepted for registration. The instructions contained in Article 49, page 104, of the July, 1920, Postal Guide are modified accordingly.
