ORDER.

Postmasters at Certain Points to Display Storm Signals.

Order No. 517.

At the request of the Secretary of War, advising this Department that on account of the insufficiency of the appropriation for the current fiscal year for the use of the Signal Service, it will be impossible to display cautionary signals, by flag or lantern, at the stations herein named, it is hereby ordered that the postmasters at such points shall display promptly in their respective offices such bulletins of storm warnings as may be telegraphed from the office of the chief signal officer.
