The International Bureau at Berne, Switzerland, has advised this Department that the Island of St. Bartholomew, West Indies, being a French Colony, is embraced in the Universal Postal Union.

The provisions of the Postal Union Convention apply, therefore, to correspondence addressed to St. Bartholomew, which hereafter will be subject to the following rates of postage, viz: Letters 5 cents per ½ oz., or fraction of ½ oz., prepayment optional; other matter 1 cent per 2 oz., or fraction of 2 oz.; registration fee 10 cents, prepayment compulsory.
