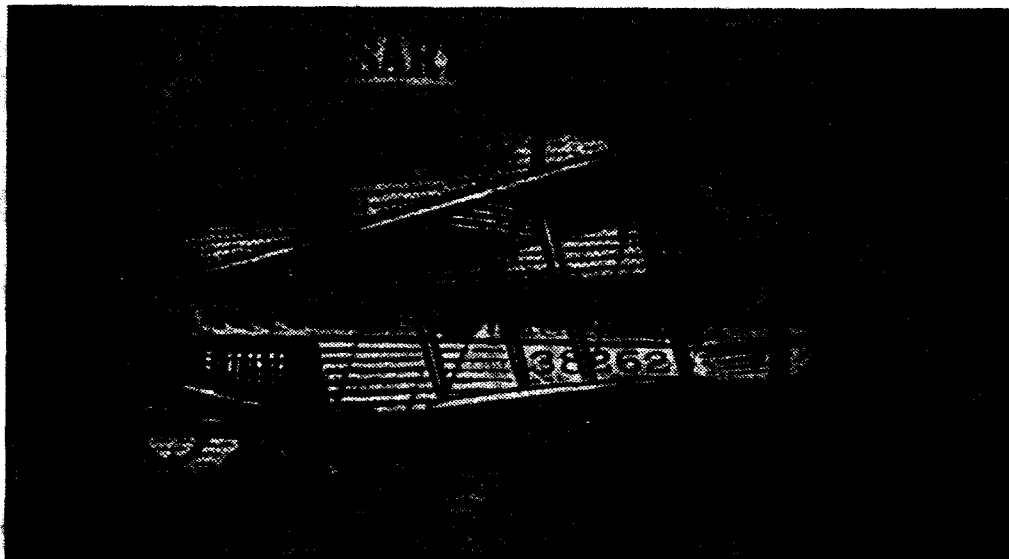

All Postal Installations

10-Cent Air Mail Service Commemorative Postage Stamp

A 10-cent airmail postage stamp commemorating the 50th anniversary of regularly scheduled airmail service will be issued in Washington, D.C., on May 15, 1968.

**POSTMASTERS SHALL NOT PLACE THIS STAMP ON SALE BEFORE
MAY 16, 1968**



Size: 0.84" x 1.44" (horizontal)

Color: Blue, red and black

Initial printing: 60,000,000

The stamp, designed by Hordur Karlsson of Washington, D.C., reproduces a Curtiss Jenney, the 90 hp. biplane that carried mail on the Washington—New York City run when the service was established May 15, 1918.

To obtain first day cancellations, collectors may submit requests to the Postmaster, Washington, D.C. 20013. See Postal Manual, section 145.3. Selected mint stamps will be available at the Philatelic Sales Unit, City Post Office, Washington, D.C. 20013, on and after May 15, 1968. All of this issue will be tagged.

First- and second-class post offices requiring more than 3,000 stamps of this issue should immediately order minimum lots of 5,000, or the multiples in section 422.322, Postal Manual, submitting Form 3356 (USE ITEM 494) to the Bureau of Engraving and Printing, Washington, D.C. 20226.

Offices requiring 3,000 stamps or less should submit a separate requisition immediately on Form 17 to the accountable paper depository. Do not include stamps other than the 10-cent airmail service on above requisitions.—Office of the Special Assistant to the Postmaster General, 4-18-68.

Shipment of Bees

Considerable quantities of live honeybees will be mailed during April, May, and June. Shippers have been requested to contact their sectional center postmaster for information regarding dispatch schedules which provide the most expeditious delivery.

Postal employees handling bees must take precautionary measures to protect shipments from damage or excessive heat or cold. Prolonged exposure to the sun or insufficient circulation of air must be avoided. Dispatches of queen bees via air must be in heated compartment of plane. Careful handling and proper dispatch will reduce complaints of damage or delay.

Instructions in Postal Manual 125.341 and 167.1 require that packages of honeybees be carried outside mail bags. Only queen bees can be dispatched via airmail.—Bureau of Transportation, 4-18-68.

*All Postal Installations***New and Revised Life Insurance Forms**

This is to advise all installations of the new and revised forms required because of changes in the Federal Employees Group Life Insurance Program resulting from *The Postal Revenue and Salary Act of 1967*.

1. Standard Form 176-T, *Election, Declination, or Waiver of Life Insurance Coverage*, a new temporary form used during the initial registration period (through April 14, 1968). It should have been distributed to every eligible employee.

2. Standard Form 176, *Election, Declination, or Waiver of Life Insurance Coverage*, a new, continuing form, similar to SF 176-T but intended for use after April 14, 1968. It will replace SF 176-T.

3. Standard Form 176A, *Federal Employees Group Life Insurance Program*, a new leaflet designed to give new employees information on their rights, benefits, and costs under the program. It will enable them to make an informed choice of the coverage they want. It supersedes BRI 41-79.

4. Standard Form 51, *Request for Insurance*, was used by employees who waived insurance and who wish to revoke such waivers. All waivers of life insurance coverage have been canceled automatically as of February 1968, and an employee who filed a new waiver on SF 176-T may not cancel it for at least a year. SF 51 is now obsolete, destroy all stock. The projected date for distribution of the revised edition is January 1, 1969.

5. Standard Form 53, *Waivers of Life Insurance Coverage*.—All waivers have been canceled automatically (February 1968). An employee who wants to waive on or after that date must do so on Standard Form 176-T or SF 176. SF 53 is now obsolete, destroy all stock.

6. Standard Form 54, *Designation of Beneficiary*, is being revised. When revised forms are received, old stock will become obsolete and should be destroyed. Designations filed on old stock remain valid.

7. Standard Form 55, *Notice of*

*All Postal Installations***ZIP Code Numbers on Postal Facilities**

The notice contained in POSTAL BULLETIN 20631, February 15, 1968, same subject, is amended to delete the words "or other suitable materials" contained in the first sentence, second paragraph. Decals are the only authorized means of adding ZIP Code numbers to the facilities referred to therein.—*Bureau of Facilities, 4-18-68*.

Conversion Privilege, has been revised. Destroy old stock.

8. Standard Form 56, *Agency Certification of Insurance Status*, used upon termination of insurance (except by waiver) in cases where an employee wishes to convert or where he retires or dies, is being revised. Present stock may be used but installation heads must add a note concerning optional insurance in Item 3 as outlined in **Part IX, Postal Bulletin, February 8, 1968**. Insurance: Interim Rules and Procedures Governing Optional Insurance. When revised forms are received, destroy old stock.

9. G 3385, *Certificate of Regular Life Insurance*, is being revised and should be issued to everyone enrolled for regular life insurance. The January 1966 edition is now obsolete. This form will be available after April 15, 1968.

10. *Certificate of Optional Life Insurance*, a new form to be issued to everyone who elects the \$10,000 optional life insurance. It will be available after April 15, 1968.

11. FE-6, *Claims for Death Benefits*, will be revised and should be available April 15, 1968. Present stock may be used until the revised form is available, at which time the old form should be destroyed.

12. FE-7, *Claim for Accidental Death or Dismemberment*, will be revised and should be available after April 15, 1968. Present stock may be used until the revised form is available, at which time the old form should be destroyed.—*Bureau of Personnel, 4-18-68*.

*All Postal Installations***Pandering Advertisements**

Delegation of Authority in the Administration of 39 U.S.C. 4009 Relating to the Prohibition of Pandering Advertisements in the Mails

The General Counsel has been assigned as the official to administer Section 4009 of Title 39, United States Code, relating to pandering advertisements. He may redelegate such of these functions as he deems advisable to regional officers and postmasters.

Chapter 8 of the Postal Manual will be amended.—*Office of the Deputy Postmaster General, 4-18-68*.

*All Post Offices***Jordan—Prohibitions**

Live bees and silkworms may now be mailed to Jordan, provided they are accompanied by an official certificate that they are free from disease.

The Directory of International Mail will be amended.—*Bureau of Operations, 4-18-68*.

New Airmail Service

Continental/Air Micronesia Airlines will inaugurate service to U.S. Trust Territories of the Pacific and Okinawa as follows:

On or after May 16, 1968, from Honolulu to Okinawa via the intermediate points Majuro, Kwajalein, Truk, Guam and Saipan. Honolulu will prepare philatelic dispatches for all points mentioned.

On or after May 17, 1968, from Koror to Guam via the intermediate point Yap. Koror will prepare philatelic dispatches to both points.

On or after May 18, 1968, from Ponape to Guam via the intermediate point Truk. Ponape will prepare philatelic dispatches to both points.

On or after May 19, 1968, from Guam to Rota. Guam will prepare a philatelic dispatch for Rota.

Official cachets and philatelic treatment are authorized for these flights as outlined in section 145.5 of the Postal Manual.

To send covers on the flights, prepare them in the usual manner addressed for delivery to addressees in Okinawa, Trust Territories, United States or Canada and prepay the postage at 25 cents per half ounce for the Okinawa covers and the other covers at 10 cents per ounce. Aerogrammes or postal cards will not be accepted.

The covers should be enclosed in another envelope as follows, and should reach the dispatching office not later than two days before the scheduled flights:

International Inaugural Service

Northeast Airlines, Inc., will inaugurate service from Boston, Massachusetts and New York, New York to Freeport and Nassau, Bahamas, on or after May 15, 1968.

Official cachets and philatelic treatment are authorized as outlined in section 145.5 of the Postal Manual.

To send covers on this inaugural service, prepare them in the usual manner addressed for delivery to addresses in the Bahamas, United States or Canada, and affix postage at 15 cents per half ounce. Aerogrammes and postal cards will not be accepted.

The covers should be enclosed in another envelope addressed as follows and should reach the dispatching office no later than two days prior to the scheduled flight:

They should reach the UN Post Office at least five (5) days before the date of the scheduled flight.

Mail for National Multiple Sclerosis Society

The simple form of address "MS, % Postmaster" will be used during the national fund-raising event scheduled by the National Multiple Sclerosis Society scheduled from May 12 through June 16, 1968. The local ZIP Code must be included as part of the simple form of address.

All mail addressed to "MS, % Postmaster (Local ZIP Code)" received at any post office in a State must be forwarded daily to the postmaster of the central city post office shown opposite the name of each State, as published in the item "Mail for United Cerebral Palsy Associations, Inc." in POSTAL BULLETIN 20623 of December 21, 1967.

Three or more pieces of mail forwarded at the same time should be sent under cover of a penalty envelope or label. Shortpaid or unpaid pieces must be rated with deficient postage.

The mail must be delivered by the central city postmaster to the authorized representative of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society in accordance with the written instructions received by him from the Society's national headquarters. Any deficient postage must be collected upon delivery.—*Bureau of Operations, 4-18-68.*

New Qualification Standards

The Civil Service Commission issued advance copies, pending publication in Handbook X-118B, of qualification standards for immediate use in filling Civil Service Examiner-in-Charge positions PFS-6 and 7. In the event vacancies occur prior to publication of the standard in Handbook X-118B, post offices should obtain the new standard from the director, industrial relations division, of the regional office.—*Bureau of Personnel, 4-18-68.*

Money Orders, Inquiries and Requests for Photostats

The Money Order Division is receiving many second requests on Form 6401, *Inquiry as to Payment of a Money Order*, and Form 6065, *Request for Photo Copy of a Money Order*, for information concerning inquiries which were submitted within the previous three to four weeks.

The Money Order Division requires approximately 5 weeks from the date of receipt of an inquiry to process and comply with the request. Second requests should not be forwarded to the Money Order Division for 35 days from date of submission of the original inquiry.—*Bureau of Finance and Administration, 4-18-68.*

Employee Welfare Committees—Sample Constitution and By-Laws

The National Agreement states, in Article XXI—Section E, that:

Employee Welfare Committees shall operate within the framework of a constitution and by-laws. A sample format for the constitution and by-laws will be supplied by the Department at the request of the Committee. The Committee may make necessary modification to the sample format to meet local conditions.

The sample format for the constitution and by-laws has not yet been formally adopted. Therefore, we cannot furnish any at this time. Do not submit requests for them. The sample constitution and by-laws will be automatically furnished as soon as the format has been approved.—*Bureau of Personnel, 4-18-68.*

Excess Money Order Forms

Some postmasters have reported excess money order forms because they had too many forms on hand when the first shipment of money orders was received under automatic distribution.

Postmasters having excess stocks should write to the U.S. Postal Agency, Stop 2, Washington, D.C. 20260, outlining the conditions which resulted in the excess. They will advise you as to the proper disposition of the excess. Do not destroy any stock until you receive instructions from the Postal Agency. All communications should contain the post office finance number and ZIP Code. Do not return any money orders to the U.S. Postal Agency without specific instructions.

Revised scheduled shipping dates for each State and Territory are shown below. They will be included in a future revision of the **POSTAL MANUAL**.
