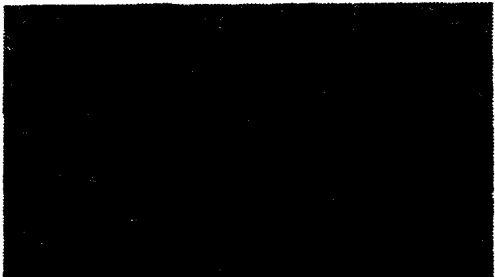

6-Cent Fort Snelling Commemorative Postage Stamp

The 6-cent Fort Snelling commemorative postage stamp will be first placed on sale at Fort Snelling, Minn., on October 17, 1970.

POSTMASTERS SHALL NOT PLACE THIS STAMP ON SALE BEFORE OCTOBER 18, 1970.

To obtain first day cancellations, collectors may submit requests to the Postmaster, St. Paul, MI 55101. See Postal Manual, section 145.3. Selected mint stamps will be available at the Philatelic Sales Unit, City Post Office, Washington, DC 20013, on and after Monday, October 19, 1970. All of this issue will be tagged.

All classes of post offices will receive an initial supply of the stamps under the automatic distribution schedule.

First- and second-class post offices requiring additional *bulk quantities* should immediately submit a separate requisition (Form 3356) to the Bureau of Engraving and Printing using item 434.

Invoice Submission

Reports have been received that adequate attention has not been given to the prompt submission of invoices by uniformed employees or to the proper processing of invoices after they are received by the appropriate supervisor.

Effective immediately, all postmasters must assure that employees submit invoices within 10 days as prescribed by section 722.621-a, Postal Manual.

To facilitate the processing of invoices on a timely basis, the following actions should be taken:

(a) Assure that each uniformed employee has a specific supervisor to whom the invoices must be presented.

(b) Provide each supervisor responsible for accepting invoices with a date stamp and assure that invoices are verified for accuracy, stamped and initialed promptly upon receipt.—*Bureau of Finance and Administration, 9-17-70.*

*All Postal Installations***Creditable Service for Leave Accrual Purposes—LWOP**

Civil Service Commission regulations provide that time credit for determining employees' leave accrual rate (leave category) is not allowed for a period or periods of nonpay status aggregating more than 6 months in any calendar year (Federal Personnel Manual, supp. 296-31, book IV, app. B, S-210) except that the entire time in a nonpay status is creditable for:

(a) Military furlough
(b) Employee in a LWOP status to serve as an officer of an employee organization, or;

(c) Employee receiving benefits from the Bureau of Employees' Compensation if the employee is carried on the rolls of the service in a LWOP status for the entire period.

A nonpay status in excess of 6 months, except as outlined in the preceding paragraph, will affect the employee's service computation date and leave category as follows:

(a) *Service Computation Date*—Employee's service computation date will be advanced by the number of calendar days equivalent to the total of his LWOP hours in excess of 6 months.

(b) *Leave Category Change Date*—The leave category change date for employees in category 4 or 6 will be deferred to the first day of the pay period that begins on or after 3 or 15 years from the revised service computation date, depending on employees category. See Postal Manual 721,313c for reduction in current leave credits when in a nonpay status.

The data centers will provide postmasters with a notice for each employee who has accumulated in excess of 1,040 hours LWOP in the prior calendar year. The notice will show the amended service computation date and leave category change date predicated on the LWOP hours.

Postmasters will review employee records to assure that Form 50, indicating the dates and reason for any LWOP granted, are processed as required in 781.451, Postal Manual.

If employee records show sufficient creditable LWOP to reduce the total LWOP below 1040 hours, postmaster will advise the PDC not to process

*All Post Offices***Annual Review of Postmaster Positions**

The annual review of postmaster positions and other positions which are affected by postal revenue is now in process. Changes in salary resulting from this review will become effective on January 9, 1971. Postmasters and other employees whose salaries will be changed will receive notification on POD Form 50.

Changes in class of office, based on postal revenue in fiscal year 1970 will become effective on July 1, 1971.

The value of a revenue unit in 1970 has been established at \$74.30. The following table of revenue amounts, computed by multiplying the number of revenue units specified for the several classes or categories of post offices and in key and standard positions by \$74.30 will be used in the current annual review:

Each postmaster at a fourth-class post office is assigned to salary level 6 of the Postal Field Service schedule in accordance with Public Law 90-206, which was enacted December 16, 1967. This statute requires that the annual rate of basic compensation of each such postmaster shall be established in relation to the daily hours of required service as compared to a full-time position in salary level 6. Seven Work Requirements Categories, ranging from a minimum of 2 hours to a maximum of 8 hours daily, have been established. The following factors and points for each factor are used:

1. Revenue units _____ 1 point per unit.
2. Rural delivery service or equivalent star route service (to receive credit on this factor there must be at least 50 boxes on rural and/or star routes) _____ 5 points.

- 3. Administrative postmaster for one or more star routes not having rural box delivery service (to receive credit on this factor the star route must transport mail between post offices as a part of the Sectional Center Facility concept; do not include routes for which credit is given in other factors) ----- 3 points.
- 4. Supervision of mail messenger service performed by someone other than the postmaster (do not include routes for which credit is given in other factors) ----- 2 points.
- 5. Patrons served (credit will be allowed under this factor when the post office has more than 50 post office boxes rented. If an office has less than 50 rural boxes, making credit under Factor 2 improper, the number of such boxes may be added to the number of post office boxes rented to satisfy the 50 box requirement under Factor 5) ----- 1 point.
- 6. Casing of mail by the postmaster at an intermediate office located on a star route (mail being cased is for box delivery and must consist of at least 50 boxes. Do not allow credit for this factor if credit has been given for the same route under another factor) ----- 1 point.

The following point scale is used to determine the appropriate Work Requirements Category:

Form 1321, Review of Position Ranking—Postmaster, is used for the review of postmaster positions at first-, second-, and third-class post offices. Form 332, Review of Work Requirements Category, is used for review of postmaster positions at fourth-class post offices. Forms 1321 and 332 will be mailed this year to post offices by the postal data centers, reflecting the postal revenue for the 1970 fiscal year.

Each postmaster should complete the applicable form as soon as possible after receipt and forward both copies to his Compensation Center as instructed on the form.—Bureau of Personnel, 9-17-70.

Form 673—Preparation

Form 673, Report of Rifled Parcel, is a snap-out form consisting of an original and three copies which have been interleaved with carbon paper. Paragraph 2 of the instructions on the reverse reads: "Use typewriter, if available; if not, use ballpoint pen or sharp pencil, exerting considerable pressure, to ensure that all copies are legible."

Employees who complete this form should follow the instructions in paragraph 2 so that all three copies will be usable.—Bureau of the Chief Postal Inspection, 9-17-70.
