All Postal Installations

Olympic Games Commemorative Stamps

Four commemorative postage stamps saluting the Olympic Games will be first placed on sale at Washington, DC, on August 17, 1972. There are four denominations—6 cents, 8 cents, 11 cents, and 15 cents. The stamps will be printed separately. Three of the stamps are for postal rates effective in the United States, Canada, and Mexico—6 cents for post cards, 8 cents for surface letters, and 11 cents for airmail. Fifteen cents is the surface letter rate and airmail post card rate beyond the United States, Canada, and Mexico.

To obtain first day cancellations, collectors may submit requests to *Olympic Stamps, Postmaster, Washington, DC 20013*. Orders must be postmarked no later than August 17, 1972. Requests for combinations will be honored. First day covers are regarded as first-class mail, so a minimum of 8 cents must be affixed. A 2-cent stamp must be affixed to a cover when one 6-cent stamp is requested. See Postal Service Manual, section 257.21. Selected mint stamps will be available at the Philatelic

Sales Unit, Washington, DC 20036, beginning August 17, 1972.

Requisitioning—Postmasters should submit their requisitions immediately for the 6-cent, 11-cent, and 15-cent Olympic stamps. **There is no automatic distribution being made for these three denominations.** Initial requisitions shall be limited to the quantity needed to meet the philatelic demand.

Bulk quantities—First-class post offices requiring more than 3,000 stamps of the 6-cent and 15-cent reg-

ular and 11-cent airmail issues should immediately order minimum lots of 5,000 stamps, or the multiples in section 222.322, Financial and Cost Controls Handbook F-1, submitting Form 3356 (use item No. 461 for 6 cents, item No. 463 for 11 cents airmail and item No. 464 for 15 cents) to the Bureau of Engraving and Printing.

Less-than-bulk-quantities—First-class post offices requiring less than 3,000 stamps of these three issues and all other post offices may submit a requisition (Form 17) to their designated center facility. Requisitions should be submitted immediately.

Automatic Distribution—8-cent denomination—All classes of post offices will receive an initial supply of the 8-cent stamp under the automatic distribution schedule.

First-class post offices requiring additional bulk quantities should immediately submit a requisition (Form 3356) to the Bureau of Engraving and Printing using item No. 462.

First-class post offices requiring less-than-bulk-quantities in addition to the automatic distribution and all other post offices may submit a requisition (Form 17) to their designated sectional center facility on their next scheduled requisitioning date.—*Communications and Public Affairs, 6-22-72.*

*All Post Offices Having Vehicles***Vehicle Maintenance**

Pending revision of Methods Handbooks M-2 and M-3, the following changes are effective with the beginning of accounting period No. 1, fiscal year 1973:

A. Make/Model Codes:

Change 1/2-ton Kaiser Jeep 64-65 from M/M 14 to M/M 19

Change 1/2-ton Ford 1966 from M/M 21 to M/M 29

B. Account Codes:

Code cost of rebuilding transmissions and differentials to detail account codes 22, 23, or 24, as appropriate.

Change detail account code 26 to read, *Repairs to Minor Components*—Cost of repairing small components such as starters, alternators, etc., which are removed from the vehicle for bench repair and returned to stock. Issues of repaired components will be at no cost since they will be carried at no cost in stock.—*Delivery Services Department, 6-22-72.*

*All Postal Installations***Incorrectly Endorsed and Returned Mail**

Some post offices are erroneously returning mail that is actually deliverable as addressed. This type of error is costly and deprives the customer of the service for which he has paid.

Postmasters shall take appropriate action at their offices to assure proper handling of this type of mail. Supervisors have the responsibility of monitoring the mail markup function to assure that mail deliverable as addressed is not returned to sender.—*Delivery Programs Division, 6-22-72.*

*All First Class Post Offices***Notice 120 (June 1972)**

Postmasters are requested to hold up the release of Notice 120, dated June 1972, entitled *Special Postal Services for the Businessman*. This material shall be placed in storage at each post office concerned. All postmasters will be advised at a later date concerning disposition.—*Customer Services Group, 6-22-72.*

*All Post Offices***Customer Complaint Analysis Program (Revision)**

The customer complaint analysis program revised procedures for collecting and reporting information will be implemented on June 24, 1972. The first reports under the revised program will cover the period from June 24, 1972, to July 21, 1972 (accounting period No. 1, fiscal year 1973).

An *Operational Procedures Guide* has been distributed for the guidance of postmasters/managers of major offices selected to submit reports to headquarters. The reporting offices selected are all sectional center offices and all nonsectional center facilities located in multi-ZIP coded cities. All associate post offices not located in multi-ZIP coded cities will continue to send complaint information to their sectional center facility for consolidation.

Major changes in the program include the following:

a. Form 4316, *Customer Complaint Tally*, dated Mar. 1970, is discontinued effective June 23, 1972. (Destroy discontinued forms locally.)

b. Form 4317, *Recapitulation of Customer Complaints*, dated Dec. 1970, will not be used after reports for accounting period 13, fiscal year 1972, are submitted. (Destroy discontinued forms locally.)

c. Narrative reports regarding complaints will no longer be required after reports for accounting period 13, fiscal year 1972, are submitted.

d. All complaints received in person, by telephone, or in writing must be recorded on Form 1835, *Record of Call or Visit*.

e. The following new forms will be used by designated reporting offices to submit complaint data to headquarters at the end of each accounting period:

Form 4317, Nov. 1971, *Complaint Tabulation*.

Form 4317-A, Nov. 1971, *Complaint Survey*.

Form 4316, Feb. 1972, *Customer Complaints Tabulation Summary Report (OCR)*.

Form 4316-A, Feb. 1972, *Complaint Survey Report (OCR)*.

(2) Only designated reporting offices will use Forms 4316 and 4316-A (OCR) for reporting complaint data to headquarters. Associate post offices not located in multi-ZIP coded cities can obtain a small supply of Forms 4317 and 4317-A from their sectional center facility for use in sending complaint information to that facility for consolidation.

f. Reporting offices must forward customer complaint data to headquarters no later than the close of business Tuesday following the end of an accounting period.—*Customer Services Group, 6-22-72.*
