8-Cent Post Rider Bicentennial Commemorative Stamp

The 8-cent Post Rider commemorative stamp will be first placed on sale at Rochester, NY 14601, on June 22, 1973. This issue is the third in a set of four stamps for 1973 called Rise of the Spirit of Independence and the theme is communications in colonial times.

POSTMASTERS SHALL NOT PLACE THIS STAMP ON SALE BEFORE JUNE 23, 1973.

International Inaugural Service

On or after May 20, 1973, Pan American World Airways will inaugurate nonstop service from Washington, DC, to Frankfurt, Germany. An official cachet and philatelic treatment are authorized as outlined in section 257.33, Postal Service Manual.

To send covers by this service, prepare them in the usual manner addressed for delivery in Germany, United States, and Canada affixing postage at 21 cents per half ounce. Aerogrammes and postal cards will not be accepted. The covers should be enclosed in another envelope addressed as follows and should reach the office applying the cachet no later than 3 days prior to the scheduled flight:

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All Postal Facilities

Parcel Post Mailing Facility

Beginning on or about May 14, 1973, an engineering prototype parcel post mailing facility will be placed in operation on a test basis at the main office at Jacksonville, FL. The parcel post mailing facility (PPMF) is a self-service, coin-operated, vending machine that automatically weighs and rates an article when the customer presses buttons for the desired services and the zone number of the destination address. The PPMF dispenses a meter-type indicia which the customer attaches to the mailed article. The indicia, exhibit A, contains information indicating the selected services, corresponding rates, total postage and fees paid, date of mailing and transaction sequence number.

All articles will be checked at Jacksonville for correct postage and the indicia will be canceled by a special rubber stamp, exhibit B, before being entered in the mail stream. The articles will be endorsed by rubber stamp for any and all services paid for by the customer and indicated in the indicia. Any articles found in the mail stream bearing this indicia, but not canceled, are to be checked for proper postage, endorsed for special services as indicated in the indicia, canceled and reinserted in the mail stream. A brief report indicating the transaction sequence number, destination of the article and whether the postage is correct should be sent to the Director, Office of Administrative Services, U.S. Post Office, Jacksonville, FL 32201. Short paid articles should be treated in accordance with section 146.12, Postal Service Manual.

All Post Offices

New Money Order System

A. Conversion to New System

First-class post offices in the Eastern region will convert to the new system starting May 26, 1973. Refer to POSTAL BULLETIN 20920, dated April 11, 1973, for detailed instructions. Note that these instructions apply only to domestic money orders (including domestic international). *Military and international money orders will not be converted to the new system until about October 1973.*

Instructions (in POSTAL BULLETIN 20920) IV.A.5. and IV.B.5. refer in part to the supply and resupply of voucher envelopes. Procurement action to obtain envelopes has been unavoidably delayed. Follow the procedures specified in the last two sentences of IV.A.5. until notified that envelopes are available.

Instruction V.H. covers the issuance of COD money orders. The mail address given in part 3 should be used for all general correspondence relating to money orders. *C.o.d. money order vouchers are to be mailed to P.O. Box 14961 or 14962 in the same manner as other money order vouchers are submitted (see part VI).*

B. New Money Order Training Material Availability

A training program on operation of the new money order imprinter entitled, *Operating Instructions for New Money Order System*, has been prepared by the Postal Service Management Institute for employees cur-

rently assigned to money order duties. It is in slide-tape format for use at units which have appropriate audio-visual equipment, and in printed version (publication 180F) for use at all offices. Supervisors must make certain that employees complete the program in advance of the date they are scheduled to begin issuing money orders with the new imprinter.

The audio-visual version will be mailed directly to offices which have the appropriate equipment. The printed version, with administrative instructions and practice money order forms, is being shipped to sectional center facilities in quantities determined by regional program coordinators. These items are not available at the supply centers. Contact your regional coordinator if additional copies are needed.

The SCF's must distribute the printed version to associate offices according to the number of money order issuing employees at each office as follows: (a) One publication 180F for each employee, (b) one administrative instruction for each five employees, and (c) four practice money order form sets for each employee. Make this distribution at least 2 weeks prior to implementation of the new money order system at the associate office whenever possible. See POSTAL BULLETIN 20920 (Apr. 11, 1973) for conversion schedule and other information on the new money order system.—*Support and Customer Services Groups, 5-10-73.*

Incorrect ZIP Code

The General Foods Corporation, P.O. Box 7068, Kankakee, IL 60901, will run an advertising supplement with a return coupon attached in newspapers throughout the country Sunday May 13, 1973. This promotional advertising will be for their Maxwell House Coffee product. The return coupon in each of the 22 million supplements has an INCORRECT ZIP CODE listed for the General Foods Corp.

The incorrect ZIP code as listed on the coupon reads 60701. The ZIP code number Series 607, however, is an unused series. Therefore, all post offices should alert their distribution employees that mail for the General Foods Corporation, Kankakee, IL should be distributed to ZIP code area 60901. LSM-ZMT machines should be temporarily programed to sort 60701 into the bin for 60901.

Customers will be providing their own envelopes to return the promotional coupons.—*Logistics and Engineering Department, 5-10-73.*

Declaration of Value for Registered Mail

There continues to be some misunderstanding by individuals, firms, and postal window clerks concerning the declaration of value on registered mail. Numerous complaints have been received at Postal Service Headquarters concerning postal clerks informing customers that they do not have to declare a value on items such as stock certificates, Treasury Notes, and other items which would require a charge for replacement. Individuals and firms must comply with section 161.241, Postal Service Manual, regardless of whether or not they carry commercial insurance.

Postmasters will make sure all employees involved in accepting registered mail are fully aware of the requirements of the regulations before advising customers on the declaration of value.—*Finance Department, 5-10-73.*

All Contracting Personnel

Service Contract Act

POSTAL BULLETIN 20918, dated March 29, 1973, advised that the Postal Service had determined and adopted the position that the Service Contract Act Amendments of 1972 (Public Law 92-473) were not applicable to USPS procurement. The following amends previous instructions (POSTAL BULLETIN 20918, March 29, 1973) relating to procedures to follow in securing wage determinations from the Labor Department prior to issuance of solicitations for service contracts:

1. It is not necessary to submit Standard Form 98 to the Labor Department to secure wage determinations for mail transportation contracts. These area wage determinations have been previously issued by the Labor Department.

2. Instructions to be followed in securing wage determinations for mail terminal handling contracts will be issued by Logistics and Engineering Department when the need for such wage determination arises.

3. The following instructions should be followed in securing wage determinations for all contracts except mail transportation and mail terminal handling contracts.

In submitting Standard Form 98, *Notice of Intention To Make a Service Contract*, to the Department of Labor, contracting officers should make every effort to insure that all available or known information requested on SF 98 (June 1966 edition) is supplied, in addition to the notation to be included as set forth in POSTAL BULLETIN 20918, March 29, 1973.

In the event the contracting officer does not receive by the estimated solicitation date, a *Response* by the Department of Labor which either: (1) Prescribes a wage determination applicable to the contract, or (2) advises that no applicable wage determination has been made, he shall assume (a) that the current wage determination (item 7 of SF 98) is applicable, or (b) that in the absence of a current wage determination, not less than the minimum wage specified by section 6(a)(1) of the Fair Labor Standards Act shall be paid. Acting on such assumptions, the contracting officer should proceed with the procurement.

First-Class Post Offices

Progress in Electronics Commemorative Stamps

Attention is called to POSTAL BULLETIN No. 20922, dated April 19, 1973, which directs post offices to submit requisitions by not later than May 1, 1973, for the 6-cent, *item 480*, 11-cent airmail, *item 482* and 15-cent, *item 483*, Electronic Stamps.

Requisitions received at the Bureau of Engraving and Printing indicate that some post offices may have overlooked the need to requisition the above-new stamp issues. In this regard the date of receipt of requisitions at the Bureau of Engraving and Printing has been extended to May 18, 1973.—*Philatelic Affairs, 5-10-73.*

In those instances where procurement contracting officers are making service contracts and, for whatever reason, a wage determination is not available, the following will be included in the *Schedule* of the solicitations and the subsequent contract:

There is no minimum wage attachment available for this contract. Consequently, the contractor is required to comply with clause (c) of form 7382 (July 1971), *Additional General Provisions for Service Contracts*, and, subject to the exemptions set forth in clause (1) of form 7382, is required to pay not less than the minimum wage set forth or as may be set forth in the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, as amended (presently \$1.60 per hour).

FEDSTRIP Procurements

Installations authorized to make FEDSTRIP purchases must anticipate their needs for Accounting Periods 13 and 14, 1973, and issue FEDSTRIP requisitions in the first 3 weeks of Accounting Period 13.

No FEDSTRIP requisitions will be issued from June 16, 1973, through June 30, 1973. All Forms 2618, *Certification of FEDSTRIP Obligations*, for Accounting Periods 13 and 14, PFY 1973, should be submitted to the postal data center accounts payable branches on Friday, June 15, 1973. Emergency requisitions received at the PDC after June 26, 1973, will be committed as of fiscal year 1974 expense.—Finance Department, 5-10-73.

Rubber and Steel Stamp Requisitions

A large number of forms 1567, *Requisition for Rubber and Steel Stamps*, are being improperly sent to the Office of Procurement, Postal Service Headquarters. Forwarding such requisitions to Headquarters results in delaying timely receipt of stamps. Correct ordering procedures for rubber and steel stamps are outlined in Publication 24, *Supply Catalog*, and Publication 25, *Supply Items and Forms for Fourth-Class*

Post Offices. Please observe the ordering instructions which require forwarding requisitions either to designated supply center or specified contractor.

Use of old editions of form 1567 which are preaddressed to the Post Office Department, Washington, DC is to be discontinued and these editions discarded.—Administration Department, 5-10-73.
