The 10-cent ZIP code stamp will be first placed on sale at Washington, DC on January 4, 1974.

POSTMASTERS SHALL NOT PLACE THIS STAMP ON SALE BEFORE JANUARY 5, 1974.

To obtain first-day cancellations, collectors may submit requests to the Postmaster, Washington, DC 20013. See Postal Service Manual, section 257.2. Covers will be serviced in the usual manner. All production will be tagged.

All post offices that receive commemorative stamps on an automatic basis will receive an initial supply of the stamps under the automatic distribution schedule. If you do not have a standing order for commemorative stamps, you must place a special requisition with your usual supplier. **The quantity of stamps to be furnished automatically will be five times the quantity supplied on a 50-subject commemorative stamp.**

Contract Personnel Screening

Contract Administrative Officials should review their supply of blank Forms 2025, *Contract Personnel Questionnaire*, to make sure that they are issuing the revised form, dated March 1972, to contractors and sub-contractors. Do not use any previous edition of Form 2025. Destroy all stock of previous editions of the Form 2025.—*Inspection Service, 11-29-73.*

First-class post offices requiring additional bulk quantities should immediately submit a separate requisition (Form 3356) to the Bureau of Engraving and Printing using **item No. 583**. Orders must be in minimum lots of 10,000 stamps.

All post offices requiring **less-than-bulk quantities** in addition to the automatic distribution may submit a requisition (Form 17) to their designated sectional center facility on their next scheduled requisitioning date.—*Office of Stamps, 11-29-73.*

Telephone Greeting

Effective immediately and until December 15, telephone switchboard operators and, when possible, postal employees who answer calls from the public, should answer: "Postal Service—Please Mail Earlier." The greeting may vary according to the unit answering, but the "Please Mail Earlier" message should be used in any case.—*Public and Employee Communications Department, 11-29-73.*

Military Mail—Storage Charges

Storage charges are not to be collected on mail articles from overseas U.S. Military Post Offices. We have recently received several reports that some post offices are collecting storage charges. APO and FPO mail is domestic mail. (See pt. 112, Postal Service Manual.)

Storage charges apply only to International Mail under the provisions in section 321.3, Publication 42, International Mail.—*Finance Department, 11-29-73.*

1974 COMBINED FEDERAL CHARITY CAMPAIGN

The Combined Federal Campaign (CFC) is the uniform fund raising method in areas where Federal and Military personnel are employed. The exception to uniform adoption of the CFC relates to areas where fewer than 200 Federal and Military employees are within a local campaign area. In these communities, organization of CFC is optional.

See the Federal Fund Raising Manual for information regarding organizing a Combined Federal Campaign. The Civil Service Commission advises Federal agencies each year of the CFC Campaigns approved for the fall campaign. Annually a POSTAL BULLETIN notice lists the approved campaigns. Any changes to the approved list (late approvals or deletions) are published in subsequent POSTAL BULLETINS before the new charity deduction year begins.

1974 CFC's listed here are the campaigns tentatively approved for the 1974 charity year. Where available, the area covered is shown.

Payroll withholding is authorized in all postal installations in CFC Campaign areas.

Terrorist Letter Bombs in The Mail Stream

Although most of the letter bombs which have been sent by terrorists to targets in the United States have been carried in the mails, none of these bombs has exploded except in the process of being opened. The two types encountered to date each require that the insert be removed from the wrapper for the detonating mechanism to be activated. In their unopened condition these letter bombs appear to be stable and capable of withstanding the rigors of handling without detonating.

Letter bombs intercepted in the United States addressed to Israeli officials in this country or to Americans of known close ties to Israel were mailed in the Netherlands, Malaysia, and Greece. The bombs were enclosed in conventional plain or air mail

envelopes of different colors and sizes, with addresses both typed and handwritten, and contained thin, flat strips of plastic explosive wrapped in sheets of letter paper, making a packet of the thickness of a bulky letter. More recent bombs addressed to British officials at various points throughout the world are reported to have been mailed at Paris, France, and contain plastic explosive concealed in a slim, hollowed-out paper back book. None of these is known to have entered the United States mail system.

No attempt should be made by Postal Service employees to deactivate suspected letter bombs. Any suspicious item should be isolated and the Postal Inspection Service notified immediately by an appropriate supervisor.—*Inspection Service, 11-29-73.*

Facing Slip Paper

A critical paper shortage nationwide has curtailed the procurement of white newsprint used by the Label Printing Centers to produce non-standard facing slips.

As soon as the present supply of white paper is exhausted, the Label Printing Centers will begin use of a yellow paper (goldenrod) for facing slip production.

Contract Program for Supply of Uniforms to Certain Crafts

The following article is a corrected reprint of one which appeared in POSTAL BULLETIN 20955, dated November 15, 1973. Previously, some important words were mistakenly omitted from the fourth paragraph. Those words are included in the article below.

The Postal Service has extended the current contract with Lion Uniforms, Inc., 2735 Kearns Avenue, Dayton, Ohio 45414, to continue furnishing uniforms for certain mail handlers, maintenance (custodial) and vehicle (maintenance) employees in first- and second-class post offices who are eligible.

An employee's eligibility to participate in this program is determined by his postmaster or installation head in accordance with the instructions previously issued by their respective regional office. Every effort must be made to identify all eligible employees and assure that uniforms are promptly ordered for them.

Postmasters and installation heads must also follow the procurement procedures for ordering uniforms set forth in previous regional instructions.

When placing orders with Lion Uniforms, Inc. for uniforms under the contract program, postmasters and installation heads should enter the contract number 72-1-02862 in the "Remarks" block on Form 4709-C, *Requisition (Uniform Items)*.

When processing the Lion Company's invoices for payment, postmasters and installation heads must enter vendor number 77774 in block 1 on Form 1498, *Uniform Allowance Payment Record*.

This does not apply to employees newly eligible for work clothes under paragraph 5 of Article XXVI of the 1973 National Agreement. Separate instructions will be issued in the near future.—*Customer Services Department, 11-29-73.*
