## 10-Cent Paul Laurence Dunbar Commemorative Stamp

**Description.** The 10-cent Paul Laurence Dunbar commemorative stamp will be first placed on sale at Dayton, OH 45401, May 1, 1975.

**Do Not Sell Before May 2, 1975**



Image area: 0.84 x 1.44 inches.

Issued in sheets of 50.

Colors: Red, blue, yellow and black.

Marginal markings: Five plate numbers, Mail Early and Mr. ZIP.

Initial printing: 140 million.

Designer: Walter D. Richards.

**Collectors.** Request first-day cancellations from: Dunbar Stamp, Postmaster, Dayton, OH 45401 (see PSM, 257.2). Selected mint stamps will be available at the Philatelic Sales Division, Washington, DC 20036, beginning May 2, 1975.

**Supply.** All classes of post offices will receive an initial supply of the stamps under the automatic distribution system. Before requisitioning additional stamps (**Item 415**), consider that the stock should be depleted prior to July 1, 1975, at all post office outlets—except designated philatelic windows and postal stores.

## Travel Vouchers

It is important that travelers submit SF 1169a, *Transportation Request*, Memorandum Card Copy (buff), along with the travel voucher, showing the valuation of the ticket in the appropriate block.

Prompt submission of travel vouchers is essential so that (a) unnecessary administrative costs are avoided, and (b) costs are reflected in the financial statements for the period during which the travel occurred. Regulations specify that each traveler should submit only one voucher each accounting period (28 days) for all regular travel (including travel in territories and possessions) performed within the period.

a. If only one trip is made and no other trip is anticipated, submit the voucher to your approving officer at the close of travel.

b. If one trip is made that covers two accounting periods, submit only one voucher to cover the trip. The cost of the trip is charged to the period in which the travel ends.

c. Submit travel vouchers within five days after completion of a trip or within five days after the close of the accounting period, as applicable.—*Finance Dept., 4-3-75.*

*First-class post offices requiring additional stamps in less than bulk quantities and all other post offices:* requisition on Form 17 from designated SCF on next scheduled requisitioning date.

**Panels.** A limited number of 8½ by 11¼ inches commemorative series stamp panels will be released with the stamps. The panels (**Item 968**) are printed on heavy art paper suitable for mounting and sell for \$2 each.

*Sectional centers:* requisition panels (in units of 10 or cartons of 100) on Form 17 from accountable paper depositories.

*Associate offices:* requisition any required quantity from designated SCF's. Panels are available on a first-come basis from all distributing offices.—*Office of Stamps, 4-3-75.*

## Stamp and Price Decals for Stamp Vending Machines

New vinyl stamp display and price decals are now available as replacements for damaged or missing decals from stamp vending machines (SVM).

Identify the type and quantity of decals required from the items listed below and submit your request on a separate Form 4984, *Repair Parts Requisition*, to the Western Area Supply Center, Repair Parts Center, Topeka, KS 66601.

Post offices not authorized to order from the Repair Parts Center may obtain decals through their area maintenance office. **New decals should be ordered only if needed to replace damaged or missing decals.**

## Requisitioning Publications and Handbooks

This is to clarify the information given in the article in PB 21029, 3-27-75, on this same subject.

### Post Offices

As previously indicated, not all publications and handbooks are to be ordered from Directives Control Division, U.S. Postal Service, Washington, DC 20260—although Form 1286, *Request for Postal Publications*, should be used. When ordering the authorized publications and handbooks listed in the article in PB 21029, a separate Form 1286 is required for each. The Form 1286 should be sent to the source indicated in the article.

### Regions, Districts, and Sectional Centers

Normally, a small supply of the publications and handbooks listed in the article are distributed to those offices specifically responsible for filling post office requests. Do not send post office requests for these publications to the supply center or to the Directives Control Division—unless otherwise indicated. These requests are to be taken care of at the sectional center, district, or region. Forms 1286 should be sent to the Directives Control Division from the regions, districts, or sectional centers to replenish their stock and to adjust their quotas.

## Rural Carrier Card Index System

Rural carriers now have the option of using a loose leaf binder form or a card index system to alphabetically list the names of customers on their routes. Form 4232A, *Customers Name and Address*, replaces Form 4232 on those routes where the card index system is desired. This form is available in the area supply centers. Postmasters should requisition approximately one card for each family on those routes where the card index system will be implemented.

In addition to Form 4232A, two new items for use with the card index system are now available from area supply centers as follows:

Item No.	Description
O-89E ----	Card set, alphabetized, 5 by 8 in. buff.
O-394C ---	Filing case, pressboard, 5 by 8 in.

Offices should requisition their initial requirements of Item O-89E, O-394C, and Form 4232A from their area supply center on Form 4750, *Special Requisition for Supplies*, until April 28, 1975. **Do not order any other items or forms on this special requisition.** Additional requirements will be ordered on Form 7380, *Requisition for Supplies*, during regular requisitioning period.

Until further notice, authorized FEDSTRIP ordering offices will requisition Items O-89E and O-394C from area supply centers only.

Items O-89E, O-394C, and Forms 4232A are to be requisitioned only for those routes actually changing to the card index system. Two sets of alphabetized index cards will be requisitioned for each filing case.

In those offices where the *Central Markup System* is not used and a customer submits a forwarding order, the rural carrier will place the new address on the bottom portion of Form 4232A and place the form in the rear section of the filing case using the second set of alphabetized cards for this purpose.—*Delivery Services Dept.*, 4-3-75.

PSM. This notice may be posted at the *outgoing primary* and it must be posted on the *Foreign Order Board at all SCF's and designated International Exchange Offices.*—*Judicial Officer*, 4-3-75.

**MONEY ORDER IMPRINTERS—SERIAL NUMBERS**

Under the present procedure for mechanical preparation of the Form 961-A, *P.O. Property Record*, serial numbers of property items are not shown. Recent burglaries of money order imprinters have made it mandatory that the detailed inventory records at all postal installations contain a record of the complete fourteen-digit serial number.

For all postal installations other than second-, third-, or fourth-class post offices, the record of the serial number should be manually written

on Form 961-A in block 14, *Serial or Model Number*. In addition the location within the installation should be shown and manually written in block 13, *Location (Post Office—Station—Branch)*. Second- and third-class post offices will post, upon receipt, the item description, property control number (PCN), and the full fourteen-digit serial number to the annual inventory listing if the item is not already shown on the listing. If the item, however, is included in the listing then only the fourteen-

digit serial number should be posted to make the accounting record complete. All fourth-class offices will enter receipt of the imprinter in the back of the cashbook, and this record will also show all fourteen serial number digits.

This system will provide for use of the record as a check for inventory purposes or for specific identification as proof in instances of theft or burglary.—Finance Dept., 4-3-75.

## EEO Program for Progress

All first-class post offices, district offices, regional headquarters, groups and independent departments at USPS Headquarters, Inspection Service region and division offices, and other field installations and activities reporting directly to USPS Headquarters, shall prepare Form 1789, *EEO Program For Progress Report*, for the period 10-2-74-4-1-75.

First-class offices will prepare and submit Forms 1789 in accordance with instructions issued by their respective region. Forms 1789 prepared by offices with workforces of 500 or more employees, district level compilations (all first-class only), a regional office report, and a region-wide compilation (all first-class only), shall be submitted by the region to the Office of Equal Employment Opportunity by April 30, 1975.

All Headquarters field installations and activities are to prepare and submit Forms 1789 in accordance with instructions issued by the appropriate Headquarters group or independent department. Forms 1789 for each Headquarters group and independent

department, each Inspection Service region (region-wide compilation), and all Headquarters field installations and activities with workforces of 200 or more employees, shall be routed through the appropriate group or independent department head and submitted to the Office of Equal Employment Opportunity by April 30, 1975.

The U.S. Civil Service Commission definition of minority designations is clearly displayed on the face of Form 1789. Forms 1789 for installations in Hawaii, Guam, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands shall display data in the vertical *Totals* column only on the extreme right side of the form.—*Employee Relations Dept., 4-3-75.*

## Apartment House Mail Receptacles

Beginning May 1, 1975, the larger size (6 by 5 by 15 inches) apartment mailboxes are required in new and remodeled buildings.

For reasons beyond their control, however, a few builders and developers may have difficulty installing the old size box before May 1. Extenuating circumstances may justify a reasonable extension of time to install the old style boxes.

Local postal officials shall review requests for exceptions from builders and developers in their delivery area and use good judgment in approving or denying exceptions to the new requirement for larger mailboxes.—*Delivery Services Dept., 4-3-75.*
