9-CENT FREEDOM TO ASSEMBLE POSTAGE STAMP IN COIL FORM

Description. The 9¢ Freedom To Assemble coil stamp will be first placed on sale at Milwaukee, WI 53203 on March 5, 1976. This issue meets the rate for mailing postcards.

Collectors. Request first-day cancellations from: Freedom To Assemble Coil Stamp, Postmaster, Milwaukee, WI 53203. A remittance of 18 cents per cover will be required to first day cancellations (two stamps will be affixed). (See PSM, section 257.2.) Requests must be post-marked no later than March 5, 1976. Mint stamps will be available at the Philatelic Sales Division, Washington, DC 20265.

Requisitioning. There is no automatic distribution being made of the 9¢ Freedom To Assemble coil stamp. Postmasters should submit their requisitions *immediately* for the 9¢ coil stamp. Keep in mind that this coil will be a limited use item.

Bulk Quantities: Post offices with 950 or more revenue units requiring more than 30 coils of 500 and/or more than 5 coils of 3,000 of this issue should order from the Bureau of Engraving and Printing, using Form 3356, in the following manner:

Coils of 500—order 50, 100, 150, 200, 400, and multiples of 400 to a maximum of 10,000 coils per requisition, **using item No. 794.**

Coils of 3,000—order 8, 16, 24, 32, 64, and multiples of 64 to a maximum of 768 per requisition, **using item No. 795.**

Less-than-bulk quantities: Post offices with 950 or more revenue units requiring 30 coils or less of this issue and all other post offices may submit a separate requisition (Form 17) to their designated sectional center. Requisitions should be submitted *immediately*.—*Customer Services Dept., 1-29-76.*

1975 Christmas Stamps

All postal retail outlets, except philatelic stores and windows, should withhold from sale the 1975 non-denominated Christmas stamps.

An announcement will be made at a later date as to disposition.—*Customer Services Dept.*, 1-29-76.

Sale of International Money Orders to Lebanon

International money order business with Lebanon has been temporarily suspended. Discontinue the sale of international money orders to Lebanon until further notice.—*Finance Dept.*, 1-29-76.

International Mail—Canada

As a result of the merger of processing surface and air letter mail to Canada (see PB 21059, 9-25-75), letter mail in standard airmail envelopes or regular envelopes endorsed *Airmail* bearing the surface letter rate of postage will not be assessed postage due.

International mail to all other countries must continue to bear airmail postage if airmail service is desired.—*Rates & Classification Dept.*, 1-29-76.

Airmail Stamps

Airmail stamps may be used to pay postage at the domestic letter rate. Consequently, first-class domestic letter mail which bears airmail stamps in sufficient amount for prepayment of the domestic letter rate **must not** be marked up to collect postage due at the airmail rate.

The U.S. Postal Service has upgraded first-class mail effective October 11, 1975, to provide service comparable to airmail *without the need to pay postage at the airmail rate.*

Customers were authorized by POSTAL BULLETIN 21067, 1-15-76, to use airmail stamps for prepayment of postage on first-class domestic letter mail.—*Operations Group*, 1-29-76.

Uniform Allowance Program

I. Contract Uniform Program

POSTAL BULLETIN 21064, 12-04-75, announced that Forms 1498 and 1961 would be issued by the St. Louis Postal Data Center prior to January 1, 1976. Because of all of the recent changes, some technical and administrative support problems have had to be overcome and it will now be February 6, 1976 before these forms will be issued to the post offices. When the postmaster or his designee completes the Form 1498 he should use number **91976** in the space provided for vendor number. The instructions regarding eligibility for this program can be found in POSTAL BULLETIN 21059, 9-25-75, and in section 422.312 of the POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL.

II. Work Clothes Program

A. POSTAL BULLETIN 21064, 12-04-75, announced that Forms 1498 and 1961 would be issued by the St. Louis Postal Data Center prior to January 1, 1976. Because of all of the recent changes, some technical and administrative support problems have had to be overcome and it will now be February 6, 1976 before these forms will be issued to the post offices. When the postmaster or his designee complete the Forms 1498 he should use number **81886** in the space provided for vendor number. The instructions regarding eligibility for this program can be found in POSTAL BULLETIN 21059, 9-25-75, and in section 422.313 of the POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL.

B. A number of questions have been received as to what vendors are licensed to sell work clothes. This is notice to all employees that any vendor who is presently licensed to sell uniform items to postal em-

ployees is entitled to sell work clothes provided the work clothes are manufactured in accordance with Postal Service specifications. Section 422.757 of the POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL provides that Publication 136, *Licensed Vendor Listing*, shall be placed at a designated point within the postal Installation, and all eligible employees notified of its availability and location. Additions to the listing are published in the POSTAL BULLETIN. The listing must be kept up to date and available to employees at all times. Some vendors already have salesmen visiting post offices and taking orders for work clothes. Vendors will be given access to postal premises in accordance with the instructions set forth in section 422.82 of the POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL.

Second-Class Publication Advertisements

A large corporation has sponsored and paid for an article to be published in a second-class publication. Since the article may not be identified as paid advertising matter, considerable postage revenue could be lost if this matter is not properly charged the advertising zone rates.

Under the provisions of section 125.52, POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL, the term *advertisements* includes any editorial or other reading matter for the publication of which money or other valuable consideration is paid, accepted, or promised.

Whenever an editorial or other reading matter is contained in a publication entered as second-class mail and meets the definition of *advertisement* found in section 125.52, PSM, the editorial or other reading matter must be plainly marked *advertisement* by the publisher, and charged postage at the advertising zone rates specified in section 132.12, PSM.

Postal employees responsible for examining the marked copies of second-class publications should be instructed to treat sponsored articles as paid advertisements.—*Rates & Classification Dept., 1-29-76.*

The allowances as set forth above that apply to bargaining unit employees are determined by the terms of the National Agreement. Any first year allowances will be in accordance with the National Agreement. For non-bargaining unit employees, the allowances are determined on the basis of surveys and studies of uniform prices and replacement needs.—*Labor Relations Dept., 1-29-76.*

Postmarking Handstamp— Item 718

Item 718, steel postmarking handstamp with automatic indexing, has been modified to include in the postmark the hours 10:00, 2:00, and 5:00, and minus PM. In order to differentiate between the old- and new-style stamp, the new stamp will be identified as Item 718H. Item 718 will no longer be supplied to offices.

The cost of the new stamp is \$40.00. It may be requisitioned from your area supply center on Form 1567, *Requisition for Rubber and Steel Stamps Only*.

The old-style Item 718, otherwise considered operative, may be modified at a cost of \$25.00 per unit. Postmasters may send Item 718 stamps, with a completed copy of Form 1567 requesting conversion and a self-addressed penalty label, to the contractor at the following address: Hanley Postal Supply Co., 2720

Processing Undeliverable Second-Class Mail

Because of the new rate structure, many publications, such as National Geographic, no longer are carrying the *return postage guaranteed* endorsement.

Postal employees responsible for processing undeliverable mail should examine such publications carefully, to preclude their being improperly returned to the publisher.—*Rates & Classification Dept., 1-29-76.*

To assure prompt deliveries, all requisitions must reference the proper FEDSTRIP number of the ordering office. *Procurement & Supply Dept., 1-29-76.*

Postal Losses and Offenses

Subchapter 230, POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL, includes the requirement that certain postal emergencies must be reported promptly to the Inspection Service. These emergencies include such incidents as assaults on postmasters and postal employees, catastrophies, the discovery of explosives, bomb threats, and other matters as descriptively listed in 232.21.

It is imperative that postmasters and other postal employees adhere to these prompt reporting requirements in order that the Inspection Service may provide optimum protection to postal customers, postal employees, the mails, and postal property. In view of the minimal number of such occurrences, postmasters and designated managers are reminded to review the pertinent provisions of those sections coming under Inspection Service requirements of the POSTAL SERVICE MANUAL.—*Inspection Service, 1-29-76.*
